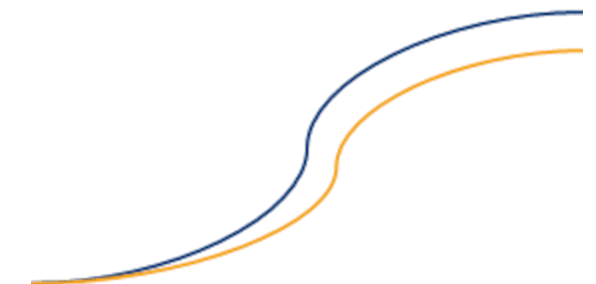
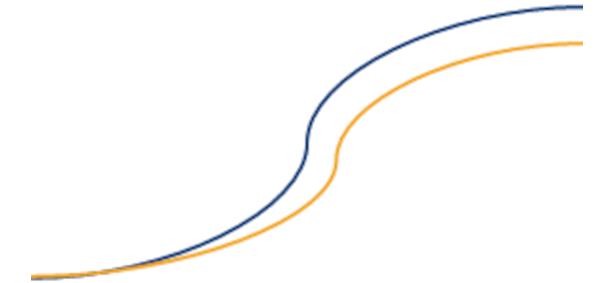

What are some club projects?

March 8, 2024, was the eighth year the Rotary Club of Morehead City had sponsored the Balsam Range. All proceeds from the 2024 Balsam Range fundraiser were given to support Alzheimer's Research and the CG Foundation supporting epilepsy in eastern NC. These Balsam Range fundraisers have raised more than \$77,300 for Rotary's CART Fund providing grants for cutting edge Alzheimer's disease research and \$32,500 for local charities.



The Rotary Club of Morehead City, North Carolina, began its annual Holiday Wreath Fundraiser in 2019 with proceeds being given to local non-profit charity organizations and to serve our neighbors in need.

What does it cost to be a member?

Club, District, and International semiannual dues are \$205.00 billed two times a year. The Morehead City Rotary Club recognizes the importance of the Rotary Foundation and Polio Plus program by suggesting that each member contribute, semiannually, \$50.00 to the Rotary foundation and \$25.00 to Polio Plus program. Hence, members receive a \$280.00 bill twice a year unless the member wishes to change their donations to the Foundation and Polio Plus program.

Member dues are discounted 50% for a spouse (partner) and 30% for a member under the age of 36.

A corporate membership is available for \$600.00 per year.
