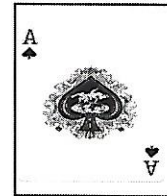
D.J. Femia Discusses Sesquicentennial Events And Activities Planned for Morehead

The speaker for our last meeting was D.J. Femia, chairperson of events for the Sesquicentennial Celebration. Ms. Femia provided the club with an update on Morehead City’s upcoming celebration.

The celebration begins May 12th and continues through May 19th. The events committee has scheduled so many activities that there is something for everyone to enjoy--beginning with the opening of the Time Capsule Saturday, May 5, followed by the opening ceremony on May 10 at the Train Depot. Other activities include an art walk, a photography exhibit, a parade, symphony in the park, a wine and cheese party, a street dance, a Homes and Heritage Tour of downtown Morehead City and an original play written by Carolyn Lyle Evans. The Carteret Community Theatre, the Sesquicentennial Committee, and the First Baptist Church will present the production as part of the sesquicentennial celebration. Tibbie Roberts, a longtime resident of Morehead City, furnished the historical documents, which serve as the basis of the play. The celebration ends on Saturday, May 19 with a fireworks display.

At this point, Rotary does not have a role to play in the celebration, but that is not to say we won’t be involved at some point before May 12 rolls around.

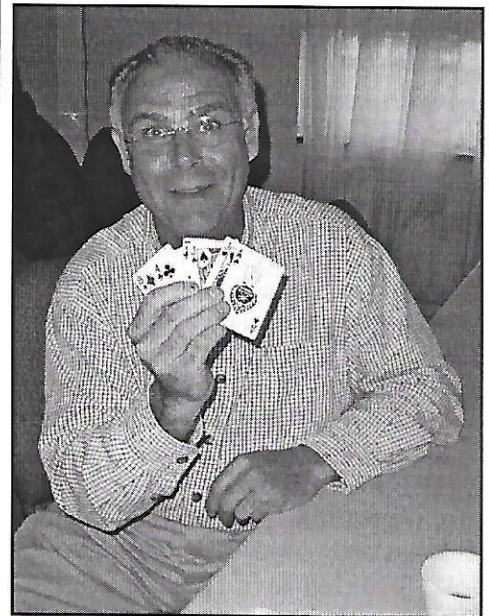

Claude Tries Again-To No Avail!

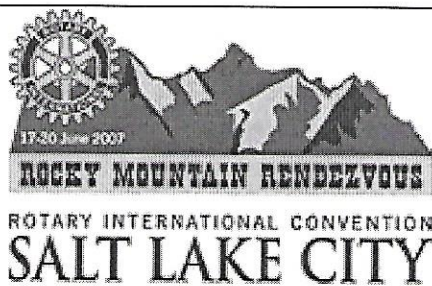

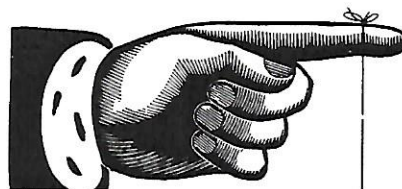
Thoughts on Marriage
