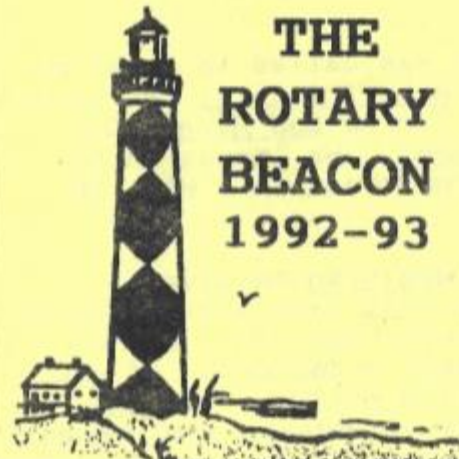
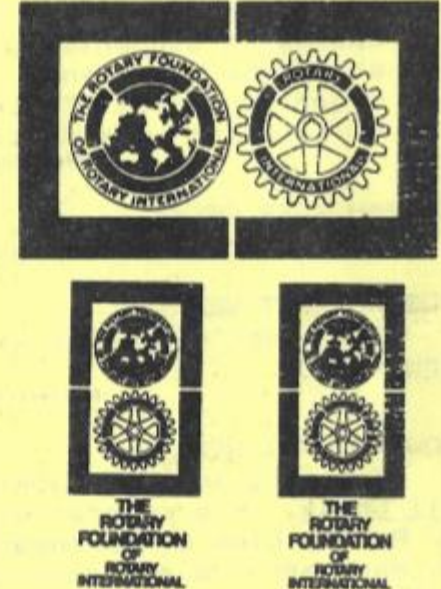
WELCOME STUMP SOUND
