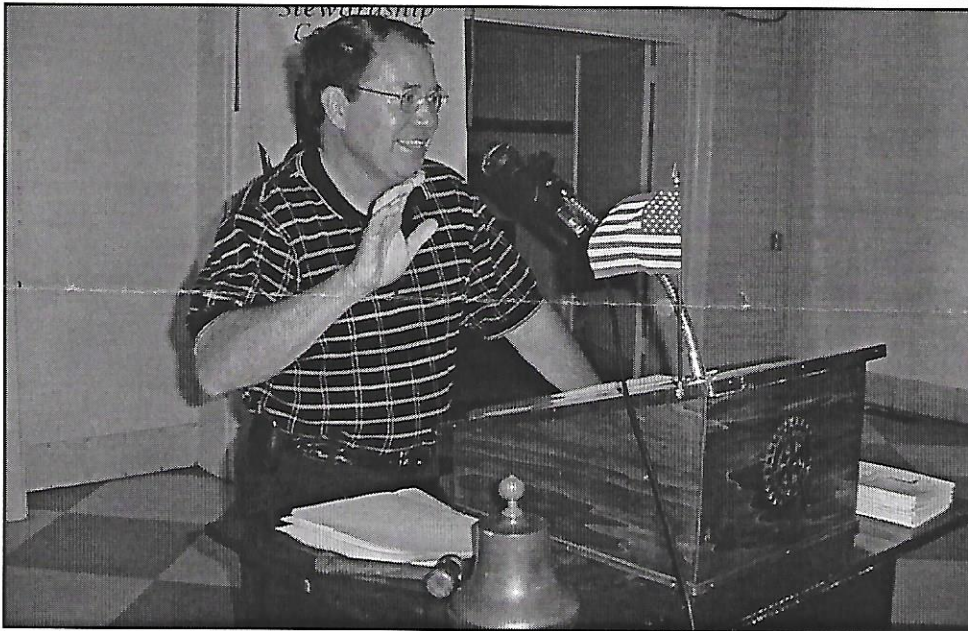

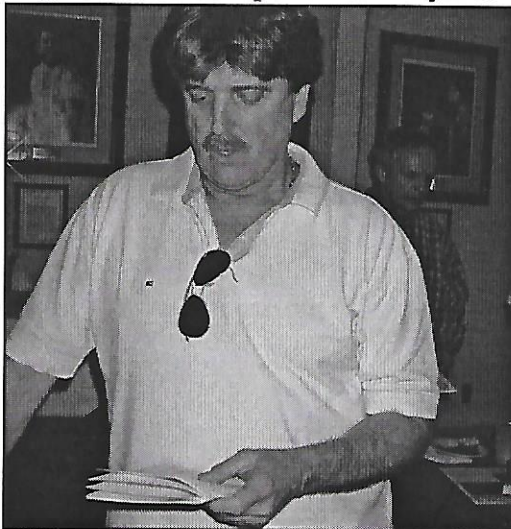

"The clinic's mission," said Jack, "is to provide services to the people of Carteret County whose income is not more than 200% above the poverty level. We provide free service to people who have any of the following four chronic diseases: heart problems, lung problems, hypertension, or diabetes.

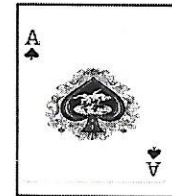
Before assuming the directorship of the BCC in 2006 Jack ran a nonprofit organization in Chapel Hill for 25 years.

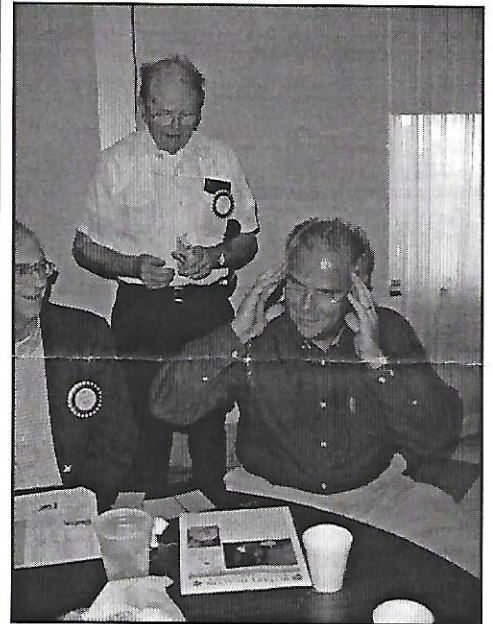
Tonight's Ace of Spades Jackpot

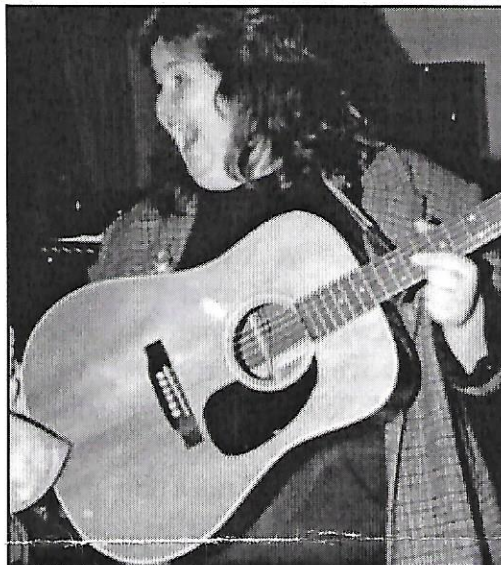

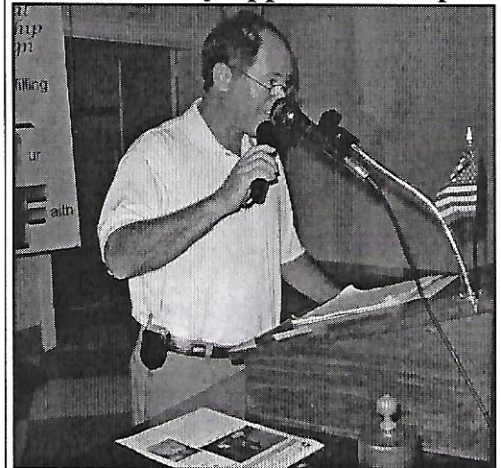

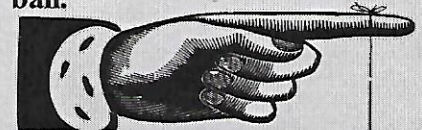
David Bradley Appeals for Help
