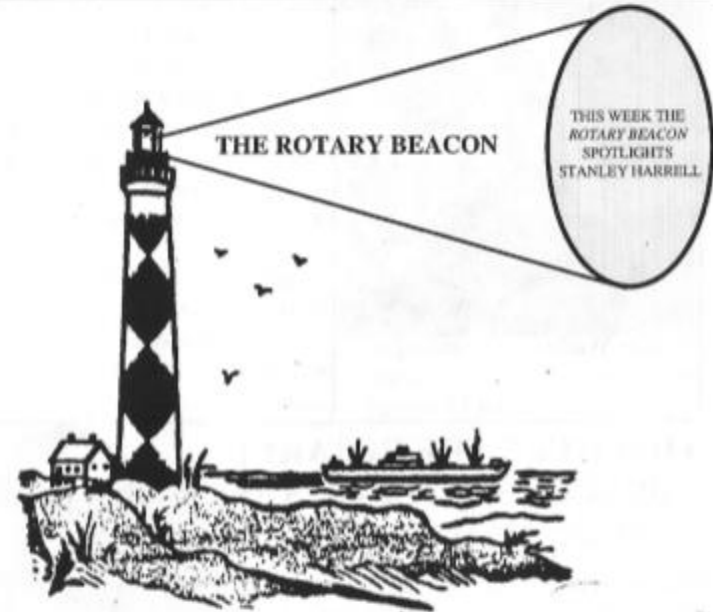

Plethora of Projects under Construction



David Walker, city manager, provides update on construction projects for town of Morehead.

Last week our guest speaker was David Walker, city manager. David gave an update of the projects Morehead City has under consideration or in the construction stage. According to David, the extension of water and sewerage service is the number one priority at this time--the goal being to reach Wal-mart before July, 1994. "Without water and sewerage", said David, "economic growth is stymied."

A second priority is the renovation of Morehead City waterfront. The waterfront will be extended from Sixth Street to Harborview Towers within the next 1-2 years. Construction is likely to commence after the Fall Seafood Festival.

Other projects include the extension of Bridges Street to Lowe's on highway 70, the acquisition of a naval vessel to attract tourists and the beautification of downtown Morehead City.

Stanley Harrell has been in Rotary since 1967. He has served as president, vice-president, director, and editor of the Rotary Beacon. 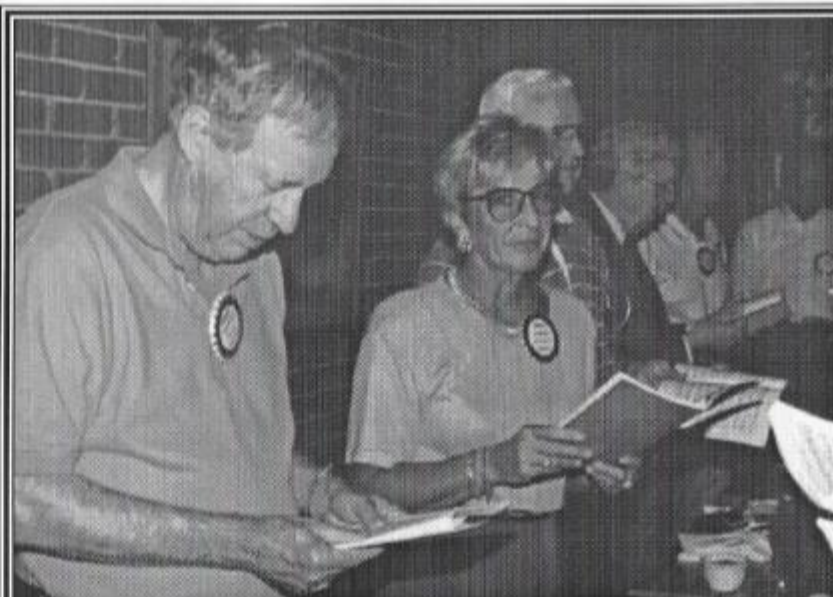
Jim Kraft, our only visitor for the evening, has a lively conversation with Julian Willis before the program begins. (These guys always have fun at this end of the table).



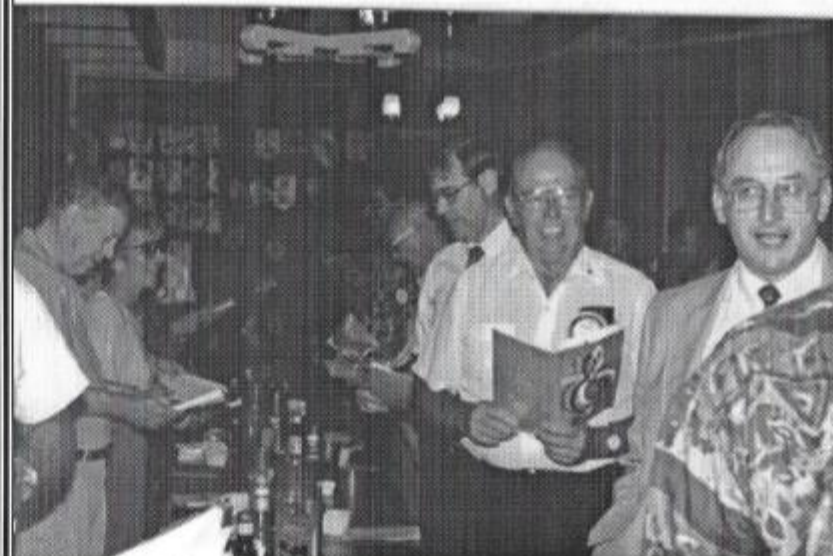

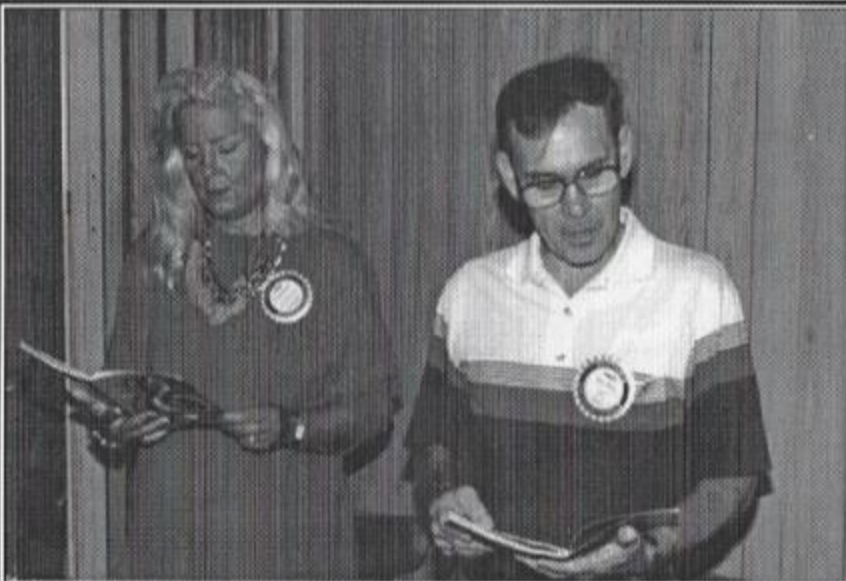
Stanley Harrell working with students--Stanley serves as Junior Achievement consultant for the entrepreneurship class at West Carteret High School.



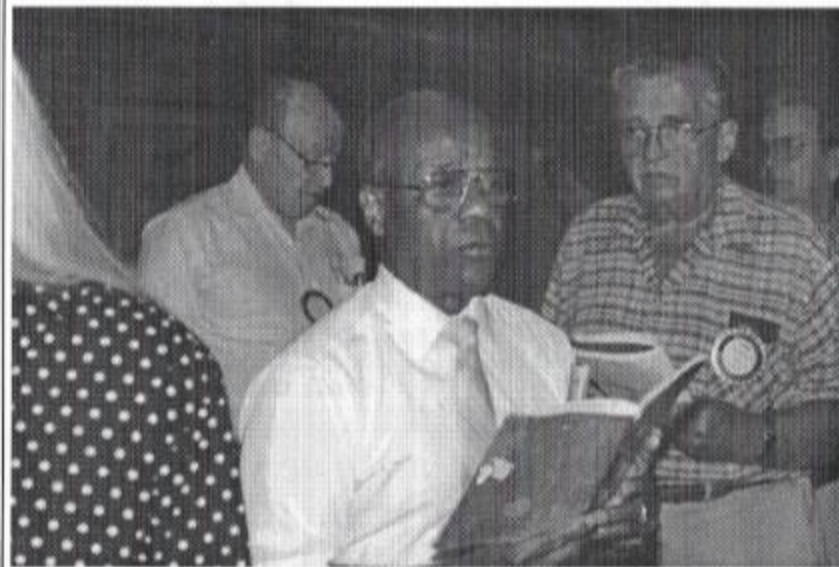

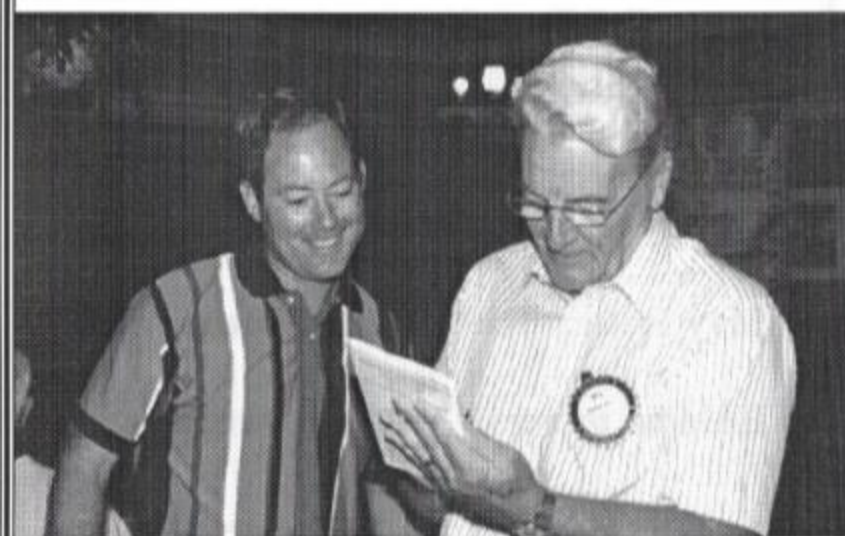

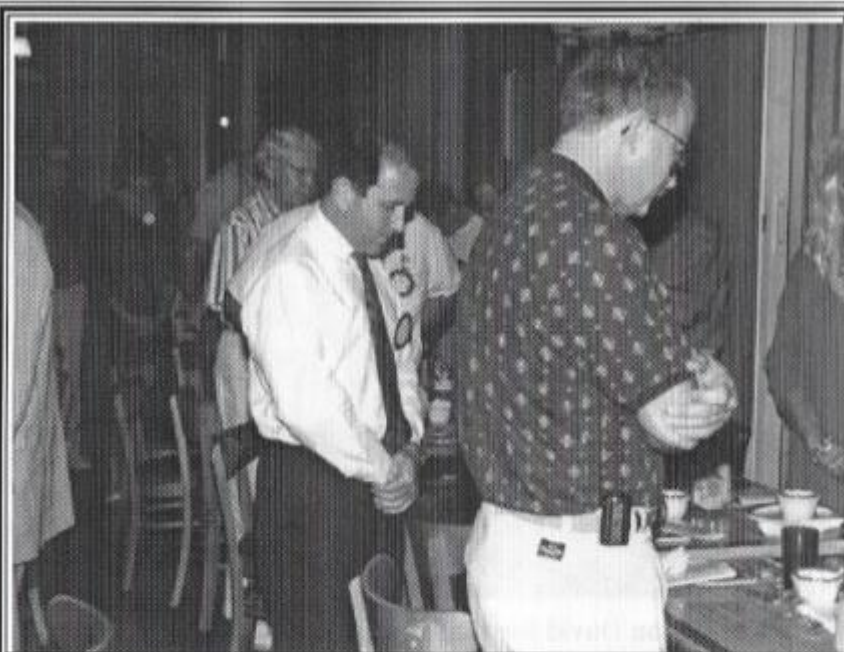
