Last week's speaker was Charles Thomas, director of operations at the State Port in Morehead City for the past 32 years. Charles said, "The port is closest to the center of the Southeastern U.S. market—one of the fastest growing markets in the nation. The port ships tons of wood chips to Turkey for use in the manufacturing of medium-density fiberboard. It receives rubber from Indonesia in vast quantities...and it is one of 12 ports identified as vital to the military. I am passionate about the port. It serves the county well."
