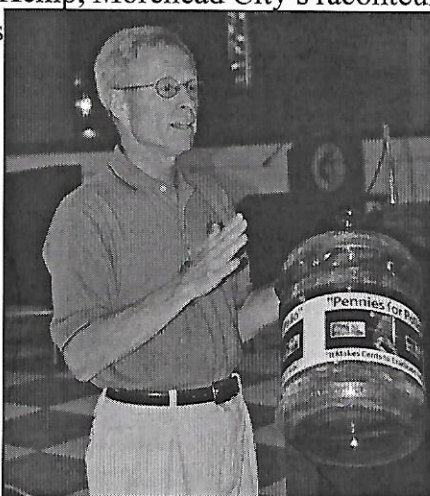

"Did you know the word Mammock comes from Shakespeare?"

Rodney Kemp Speaks on the Accents and Derivation of Words--Especially in Carteret County

Last week's guest speaker was Rodney Kemp, Morehead City's raconteur par excellence. Rodney's topic was: Accents and work derivations. Local accents are part of local dialects. Any dialect of English has unique features in pronunciation, vocabulary, and grammar. The term "accent" describes only the first of these, namely, pronunciation. The word that gets the most attention in Carteret County is mammocked which comes from Shakespeare's play Coriolanus, act 1, scene iii: Here is the passage the word is taken from:

Rodney uses many examples of words peculiar to Carteret County to show how language varies from place to place. As always, Rodney was very entertaining and thought provoking.

TONIGHT'S PROGRAM

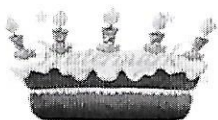

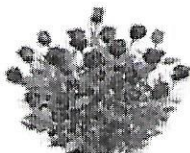
