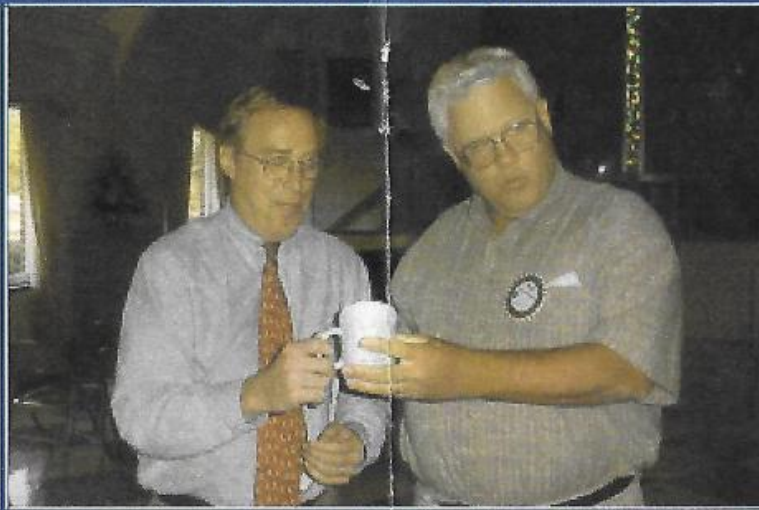
Rotary Foundation Week: Nov. 11-15
