Promise Land Society Organized To Preserve a Piece of Morehead City's History

Rodney Kemp, Morehead City's raconteur par excellence, has taken on a new role...that of unofficial historian of The Promise Land, a section of Morehead City that runs between 12th and 15th Streets on Evans, Shackelford and Shepard Streets. With the help of his friend, Bob Guthrie, Rodney has formed The Promise Land Society for the purpose of collecting stories and anecdotes to preserve the heritage of a community that transplanted itself from Shackelford Banks to The Promise Land to escape the wrath of storms that plagued Diamond City in the early 19th Century.

Rodney said he was surprised at the interest in the project. "More than 80 people turned out for our first meeting. Everyone had a story to tell. The group even came up with an idea for a logo to imprint on a T-shirt--a fig tree, or perhaps a yaupon with a skiff and fishing net in the background."

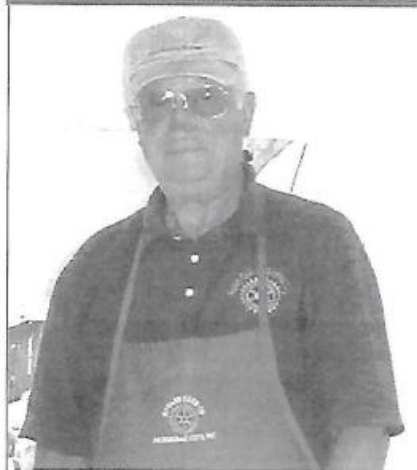

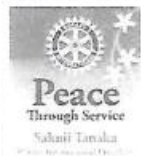
