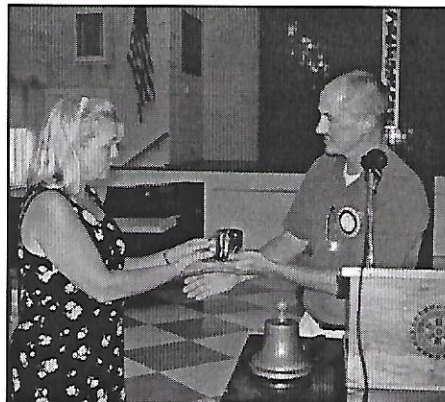
Annette Springle Says Carolina House Believes In Enriching the Lives of Residents

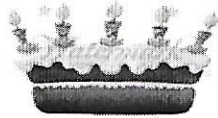

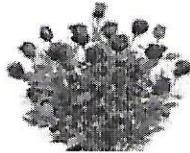

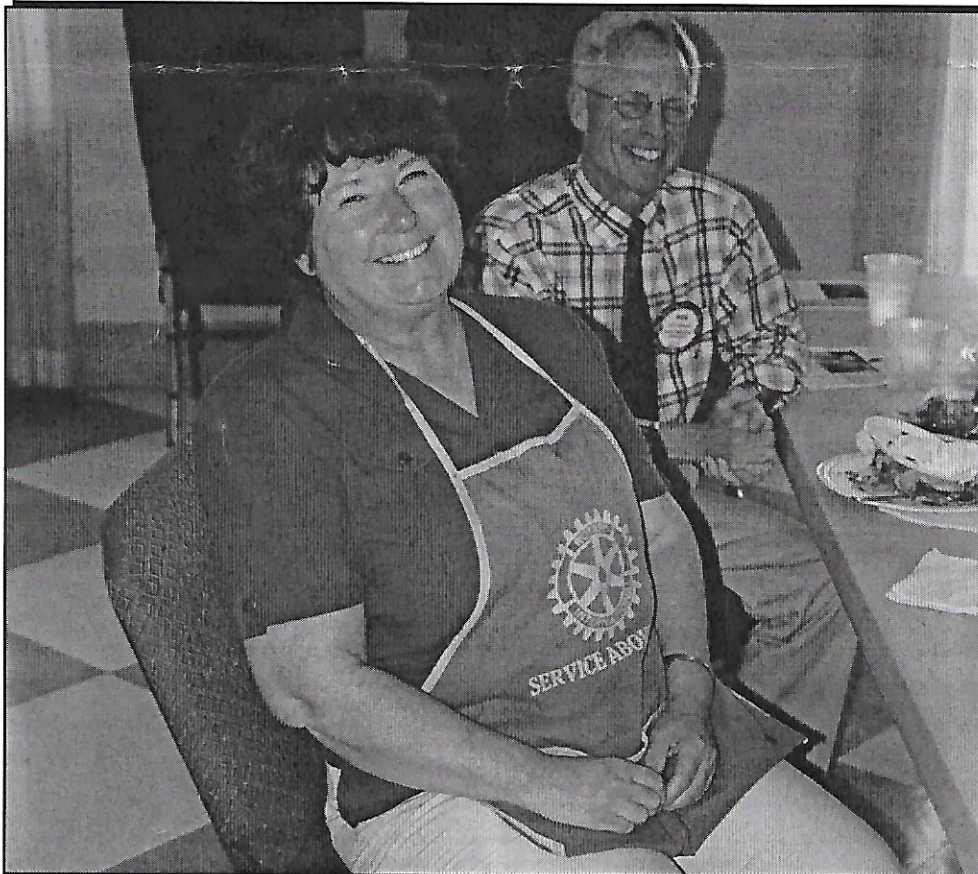
