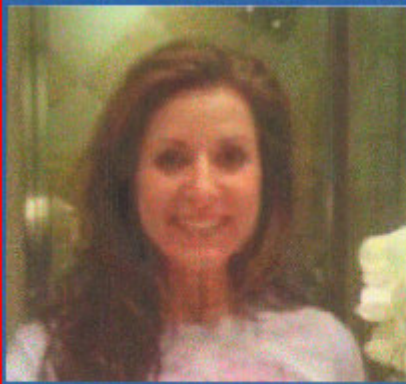
**District Governor Don Adkins
