

LAST WEEK – PASTOR PATRICK WHALEY



“Success to Significance” was the thought-provoking message that Rev. Patrick Whaley wanted us to think about. Pastor Whaley is the full-time Hospice Chaplain and an Associate Pastor at First United Methodist Church. From 1989 to 2005 Pastor Whaley spent up to 2 months each year in Russia and other

countries close to Russia as part of mission outreach. Beginning in 2006 he lived and worked in Russia full time, retiring in December 2016. The idea of hospice care excited his Russian friends, and he brought a Hospice Care Team to a Russian university due to the interest generated there.

The Russian people, in Patrick’s experience, experience neither success nor significance, but the path from one to the other is at the base of his passion for service. We have all experienced success in our lives – raising a family, starting a business, expanding our career to retirement. What he asks us to do is take stock of our lives and ask ourselves if our lives are “significant” – are we using our God-given talents to help others? He stated that 2/3rds of families don’t have a church home or close friends, and men are more prone to the lack of supportive social relationships than are women. He listed several opportunities to create significance in our lives: visiting hospice patients – especially men, get to really know our families – invest the time and effort, play music, write poems and books, make a difference to someone, anyone, by volunteering and being a part of their lives.
