Charlie Miller, Executive Director of Crystal Coast Hospice House Explains Hospice Care

“Hospice care is a unique concept. Hospice supports people near the end of life by: developing individualized care plans focused on each patient’s goals and wishes; by managing symptoms and pain; by improving quality of life; and by encouraging patients and their families to make the most of their time together. Once a patient is deemed eligible for hospice by their physician the transition can start as soon as they—or the person who is designated to make healthcare decisions on their behalf—agrees to transitions from a curative focus and begin hospice services.”
