

Charles Thomas describes crisis at port

Morehead City Port Needs Dredging Current Depth Critically Low

Herb Phillips had the program last week. His guest speaker was Charles Thomas, a staff member for the Morehead City Port Authority. The MC Port, Charles said is one of the deepest ports on the US East Coast, located just four miles from the Atlantic Ocean. The port handles both breakbulk and bulk cargo and is the second largest importer in the country for natural rubber. The port has a 177,000 square foot warehouse that is available to house high value commodities such as paper, steel, and lumber. The warehouse features 29 foot ceilings and easy access to ocean berths.

"The port does, however, have a problem," said Charles. "Many ships can barely enter the Port of Morehead City because the channel is too shallow. The authorized navigable depth at the Port is around 45 feet, but because of accelerated shoaling that we've seen here in Morehead City, that depth is down to 32-34 feet, which means that we may not be able to accommodate some vessels in the near future. However, we expect dredging to begin in April and be completed by June."


