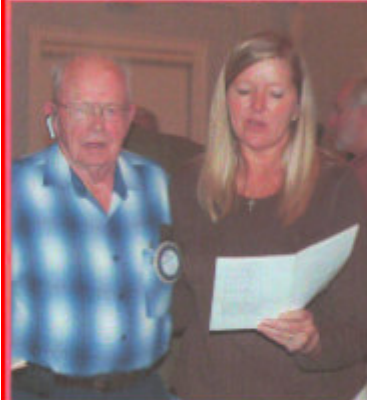


BET DOWTY, 1928-2013 ROTARY'S UNSUNG HERO
