Fund Raising Ideas Proposed by the Board of Directors

Two fundraising projects were proposed by the board of Directors at the February Meeting. First, the major fundraising idea was to sponsor Balsam Range, a bluegrass band that creatively blends bluegrass with folk, gospel and jazz into a new American acoustic music experience. The concert would be held at Morehead City's new Community Theatre location sometime in early fall. Tickets would sell for \$30 each. The theatre seats 550. If all tickets were sold, the club could raise \$9,500 after expenses.

The second idea was to raffle off a \$500 iPad at \$5 per ticket. The club could raise \$2,000 if 500 tickets were sold. All that is needed now is a committment from club members to support both projects. What think Ye? Do we have the will and enthusiasm to see these two fundraising projects to a successful conclusion?
