



# Ronald McDonald House--A Place Where Parents Of Sick Children Can Stay

Council Renfrow has the program tonight. His guest speaker is Phyllis Frye (pictured at right), director of Ronald McDonald House. A Ronald McDonald House is a place where the parents of children that are in a nearby hospital can stay at night for reduced or no cost. The first Ronald McDonald House opened in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 1974.

Ronald McDonald Houses are financially supported by donations from the public and corporate donors who form marketing partnerships with other organization to raise money. In many McDonald's restaurants, collection canister are placed on the counter to encourage patrons to support the foundation with donations which are forwarded to the Ronald McDonald Houses. The houses are not owned or operated by the McDonald's company, but the company provides the houses with free equipment and services to reduce the operating costs and to increase public awareness through fund-raising events.




