

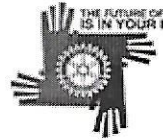

Charlotte Farris Conducts Interesting Tours for Groups That Wish To Experience the Beauty of Carteret County

Sonny Geer had the program last week. His guest speaker was Charlotte Farris. Charlotte is a tour guide for Carteret County. For 32 years, Charlotte has been teaching students at the community college how to lead groups on tours of Carteret County, improve the quality of life of people of varying abilities, and to design activities to appropriate to individual age groups. The tours which Charlotte conducts for the community college are self-sustaining. This semester has tours scheduled for Aurora, Down East and Montford Point. The cost of the tours range from \$25-\$35 . Charlotte said the people most likely to sign up for her tours include new comers to the county and retirees. But she said: "Many people who have lived here for years also take the tours....especially the tour of Portsmouth Village. Other tours include Open Grounds Farm, Merrimon, South River, Lukens, Hammock State Park, and Croatan National Forest with special emphasis on the Coastal Federation hiking and camping areas.

Charlotte said, "Some people take the course once, and other repeat the course several times. A great deal of emphasis is placed on the heritage, language (brogue and local phrases or idioms) and the environment including native plants and wildlife. I suppose I take people to all the places Rodney Kemp tells them about.

Charlotte is always interested in improving her course, If you have suggestions for places you would like to visit, drop Charlotte a note. She would love to design a tour to your favorite tourist attraction.

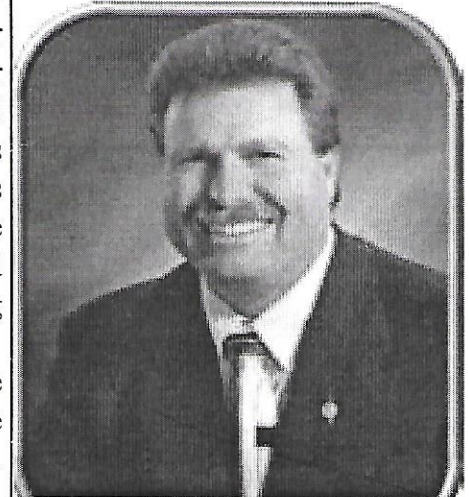

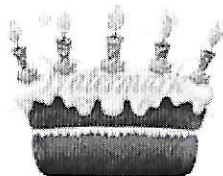
Jim Gregson has the program tonight. His guest speaker is Gerald A. "Jerry" Jones, Jr., Mayor of Morehead City.

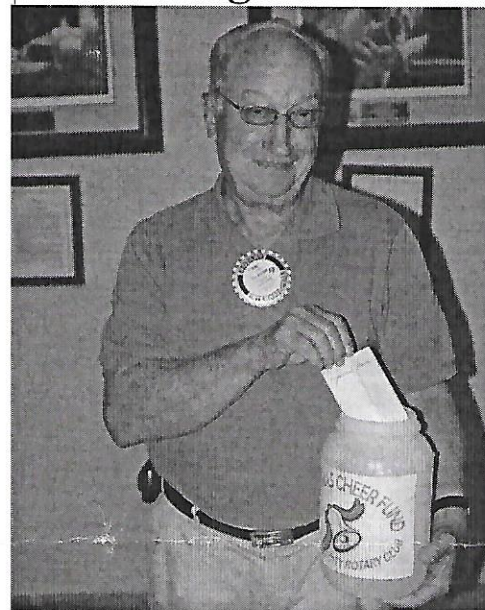
RYLA
