

Daniel Fischler wants to raise \$20,00 to purchase textbooks

Ten Year Old Textbooks Need to Be Replaced

Last week's guest speaker was Daniel Fischler, a junior at West Carteret High School and founder of the Youth and Government Club. Daniel is on a mission to raise \$20,000 to purchase new textbooks for the Social Studies Department at WCHS. "The books are out of date and falling apart," said Daniel. "The school's budget is not sufficient to purchase new books for all courses. Math and English classes get priority. New textbooks for the AP Government class are a low priority,"

Daniel is appealing to civic and service clubs in Carteret County to help ameliorate the problem. The Morehead City Rotary Club's board of directors will discuss Daniels' request at the January board meeting.


