



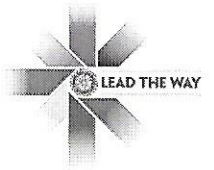

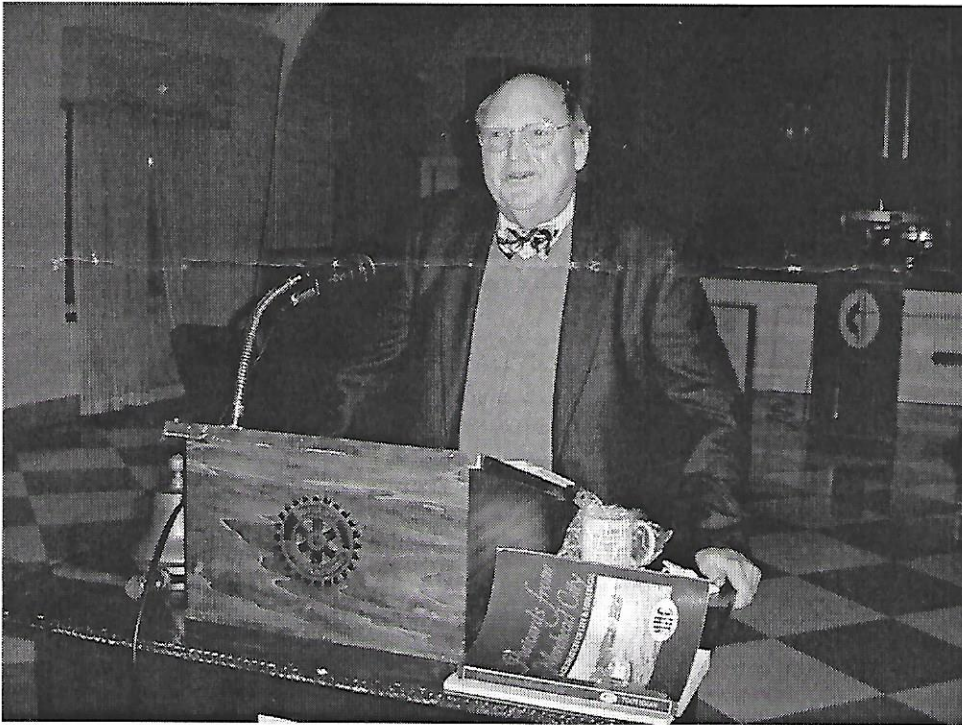

available January 22. Copies can be obtained from The History Place. The cookbook, another project will be out soon also...probably around the same date.

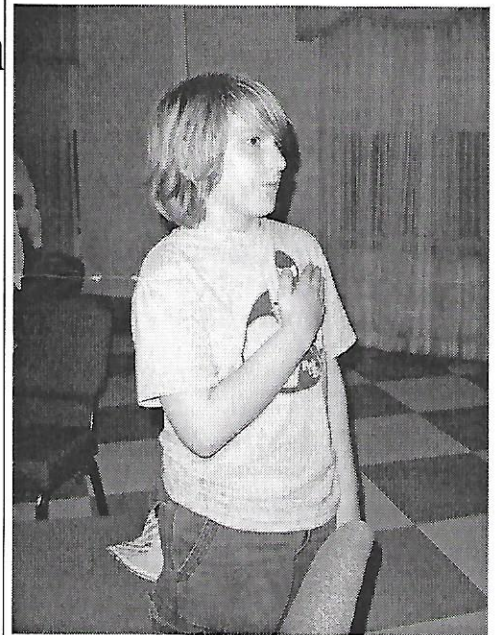
The history committee also want to determine the geographical limits of Promised Land and how it was named.
