Brett Parkhurst Lists Warning Signs of Strokes

US Has More Strokes Victims Than Most Modern Nations in the World


Last week's speaker was Brett Parkhurst. Brett coordinates a team at Carteret General Hospital that treats patients who have had strokes.Brett said it is likely that 1 out of 3 persons will have a stroke sometime during their lifetime. Often the stroke will go unnoticed.

There are, however, warning signs of a stroke. You may be experiencing a stroke if there is a sudden numbness or weakness on one side of your body. Other signs are sudden confusion and trouble understanding or speaking. You may also experience trouble seeing, sudden dizziness, difficulty walking or loss of balance. And finally, you may experience a sudden severe headache for no apparent reason.

If you think someone is having a stoke, you should act fast. Ask him/her to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward? Ask the person to repeat a simple sentence. Are the words slurred? When the person smiles, does one side of the face droop? If the answer is yes to any of these questions, call 911 fast.

The incomming GSE team arrives in Fayetteville on February 28th and returns to Argentina March 30th. The team is composed of three women and two men. The team leader is a mechanical engineer and the other four members of the team are physicians and one psychologist. Area 1 (Beaufort, MHC, Newport) will be receiving the handoff from Wilmington on Friday, March 16th. That Friday and Saturday (March 16 & 17) is considered to be the "Mid-Exchange Break". For those 2 days & nights, the team will be staying in a hotel or condo locally (probably either the Ocean Club at Pine Knoll Shores or the Inlet Inn in Beaufort). This is their time to re-charge and there will be no Rotary functions that weekend (that is also PETS weekend).

Bill Kaeser is now in the process of scheduling activities for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Host families are asked to drop the team members off at a designated location each morning and pick them up in the evening. The Beaufort Club will arrange transportation for each day's activities.
