## Open Enrollment for Affordable Care Act Expires February 15--Sign Up Now

George Henderson had the program last week. His guest speaker was Holly Powell, a certified Navigator, sponsored by the Legal Aid of North Carolina. Holly had the difficult task of explaining the New Affordable Care Act, commonly referred to as Obama Care. Holly said that under the Affordable Care Act most Americans can now secure insurance even if they have preexisting conditions. This is good news to many Americans who previously were unable to find



an insurance company that would provide coverage. Holly also explained that individuals who refuse to purchase insurance will be required to pay a fee for going without coverage. The fee is 2% of one's yearly income or \$325, or whichever is more. Tax returns are used to monitor this provision of the law. However, if one's income is too low and a tax return is not required, then the penalty is nullified.


