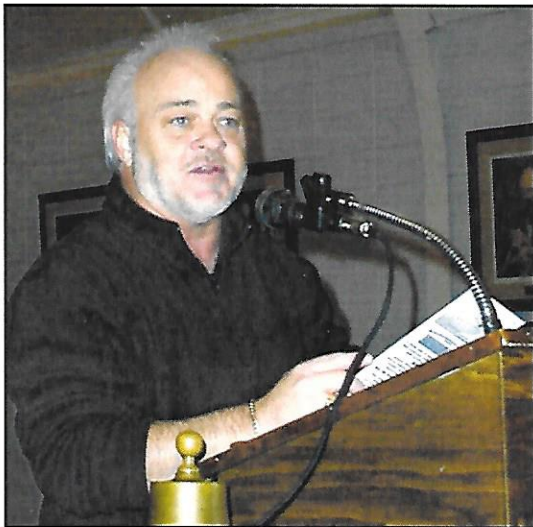

Freddie Pierce, left, from the Crystal Coast Jamboree, performs as Jerry Clower, one of his many routines.

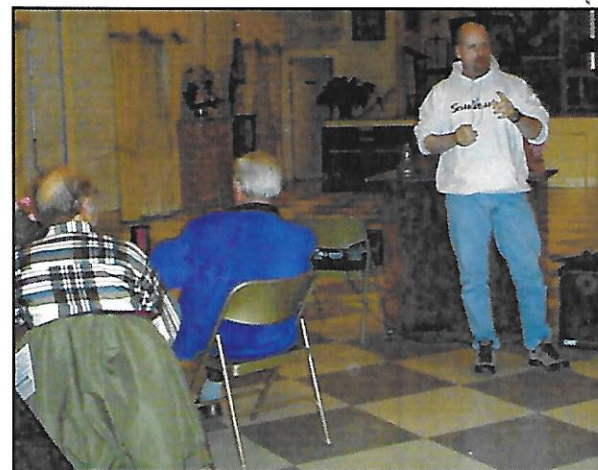
