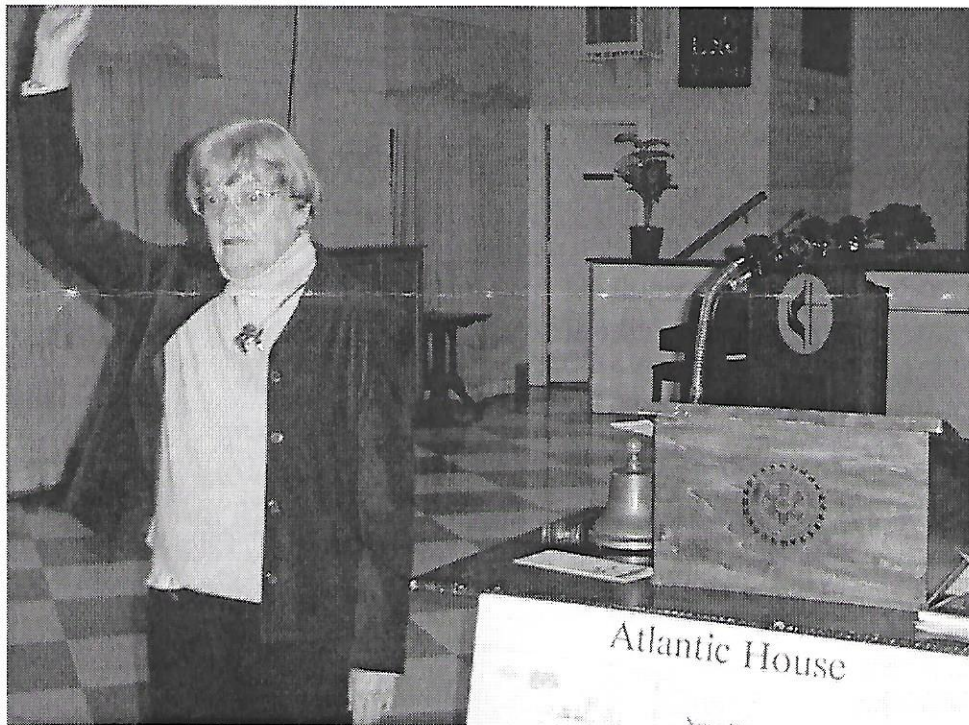

Friends of Atlantic House To Construct New Facility Soon

Last week's guest speaker was Judy Spitzbergen, volunteer grant writer for Atlantic House--a model clubhouse for psychosocial rehabilitation. Individuals who use Atlantic House facilities are not patients, they are members. At Atlantic House they build on members' strengths and capabilities, journeying step-by-step from isolation and dependence to self-reliance and productivity. Members gain self-confidence by helping operate the program.

Recovery is the goal of every person with a severe and persistent mental illness.

Atlantic House is a solution to escalating health care costs and an ever changing state system.

All members contribute something to the operation of Atlantic House, from writing and printing the newsletter to running the operation on a day-to-day basis.

The local chapter of Atlantic House has raised over \$800,000 to build a new facility. This is enough money to take care of all costs except furnishings for the building.

The Clubhouse Model began in 1948 at Fountain House in New York City. Today there are over 300 programs around the world that follow this form of rehabilitation.

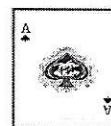
A New Year's Rhyme

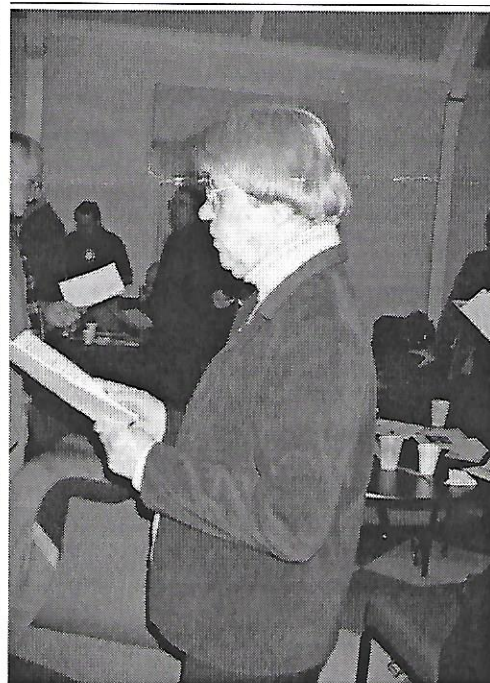

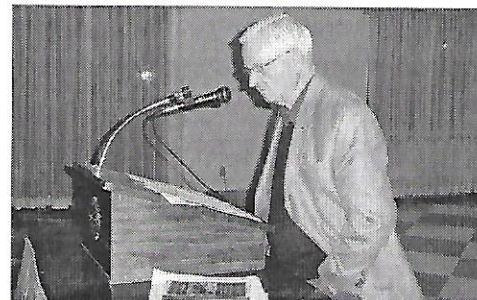
