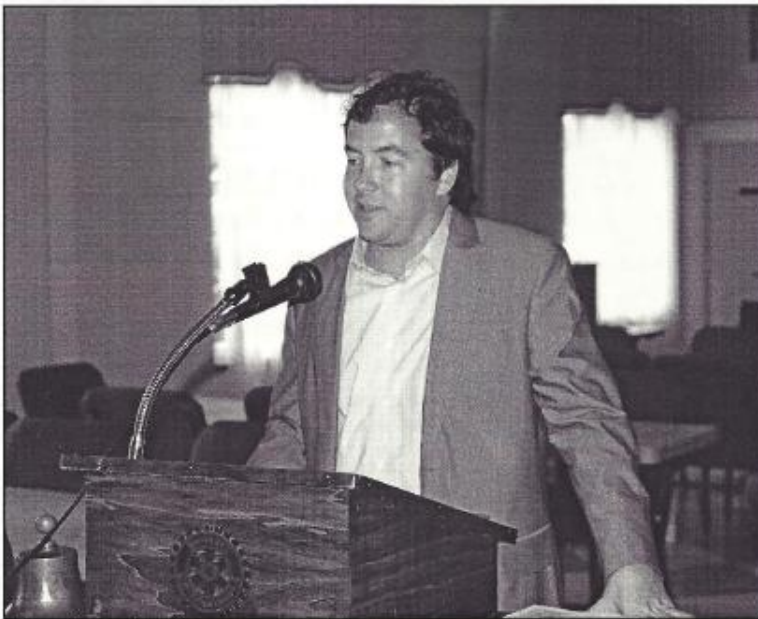

Atlantic Beach Mayor To Discuss Challenges for the New Year

David Bradley has the program tonight. His guest speaker is Trace Cooper, Mayor of Atlantic Beach, our neighbor just across the sound that is known for its abundance of public beaches and friendly people. The Town of Atlantic Beach's municipal government is comprised of five Council members and the Mayor. The Council members and Mayor are elected for two-year terms, elected at-large. The Mayor is the "Chairman" of the Town Council, and presides at all meetings, only voting to break a tie. When the Mayor is absent, the Mayor Pro Tem conducts meetings. The town works to balance the needs of its citizens, visitors, businesses, and the delicate coastal environment.

Tonight the mayor will review some of the most significant projects and challenges he faced last year and give us a look into what the future holds for Atlantic Beach for the coming year.

Mayor Cooper, a life long resident of Carteret County, is a graduate of Columbia University Law School and holds a BA degree in French and Economics from Vassar College. He is the founder & principal at Cooper Law Firm and Cooper Development. Trace has been mayor of Atlantic Beach since December 2007.
