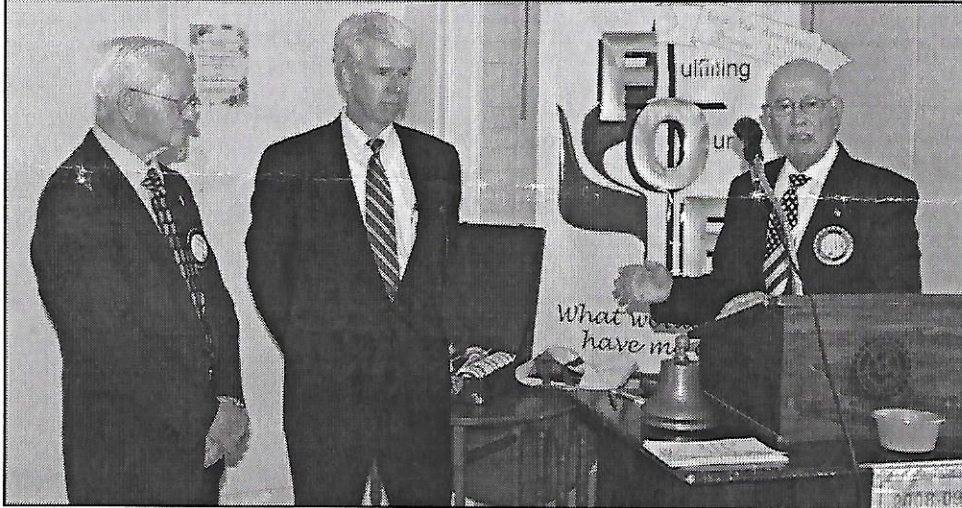

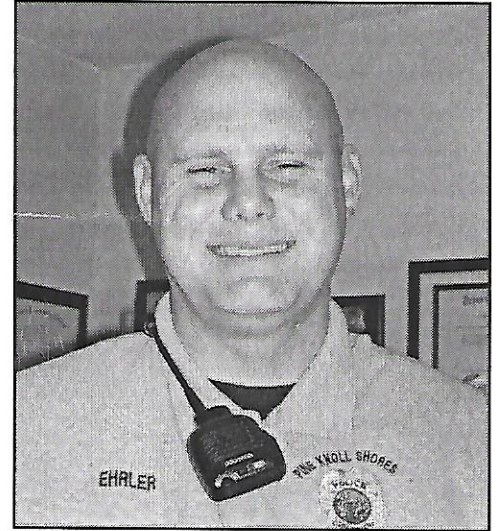
### Council Renfrow sworn in as new president: Neil Whitford receives Past President pin from Anne

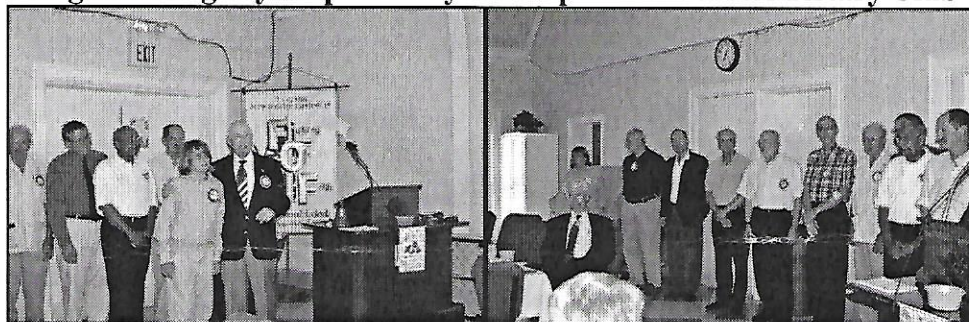
