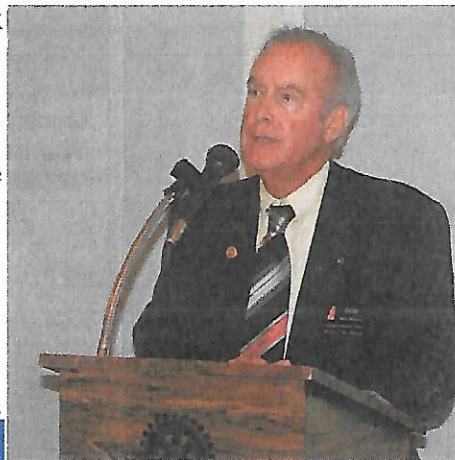

Gerald Godette - Installed President Of Morehead City Evening Rotary

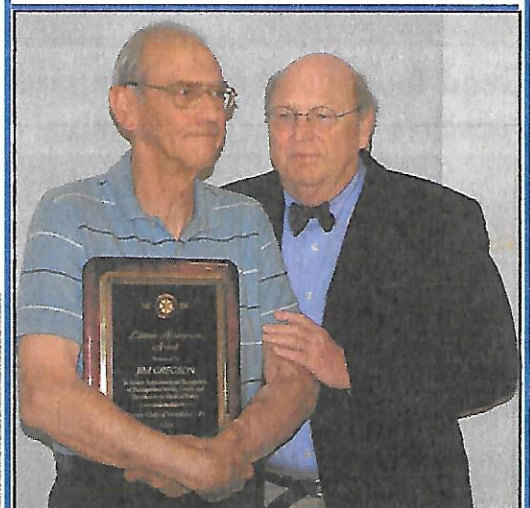

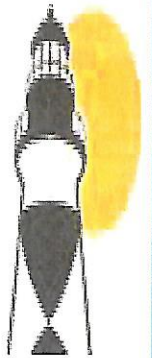
