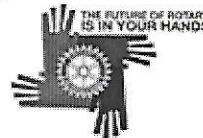

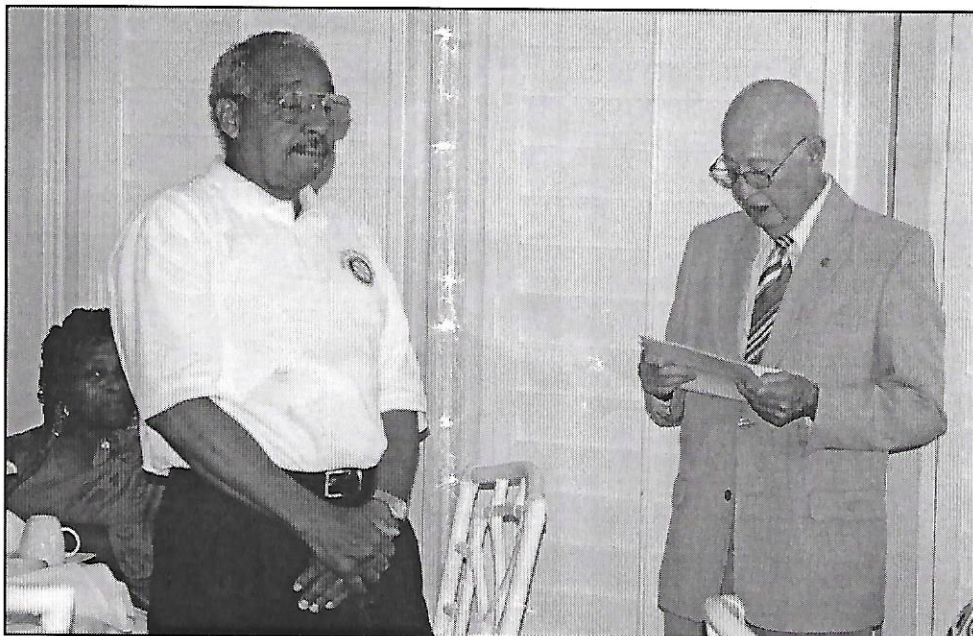

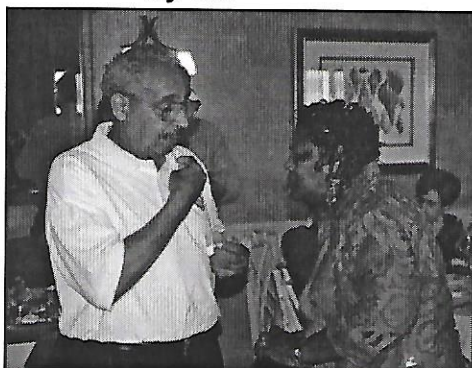
Tommy Noe Installs James Walker

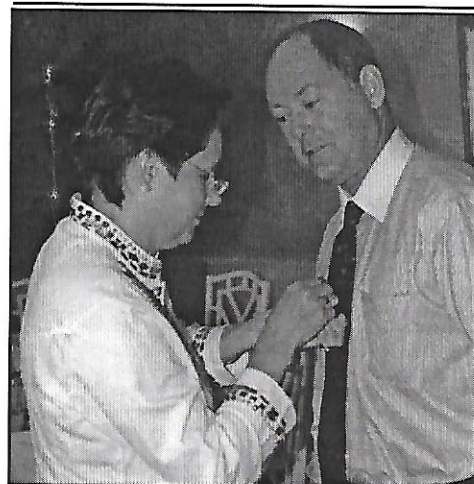

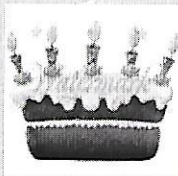

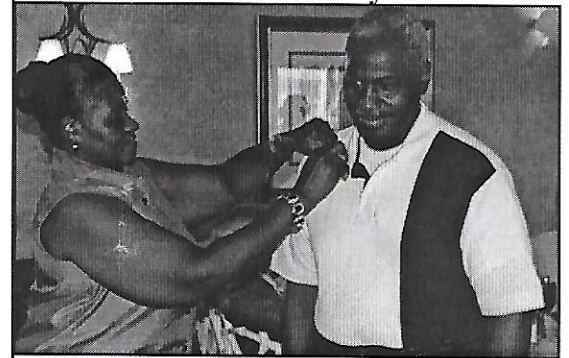
