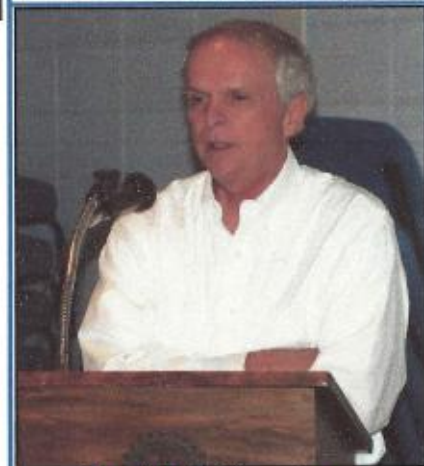
### Read Bulletin On-Line

4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

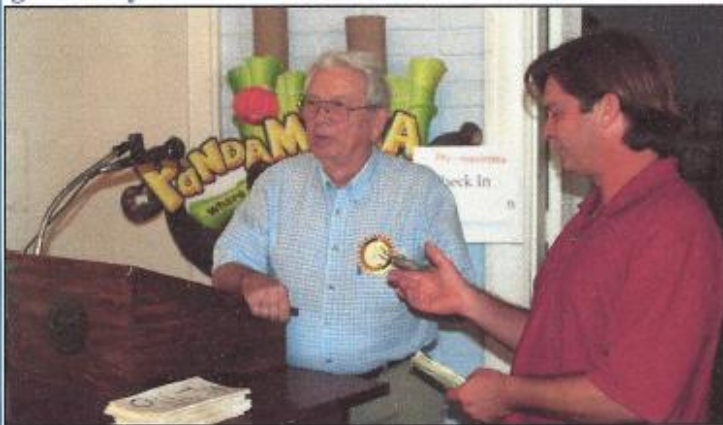
