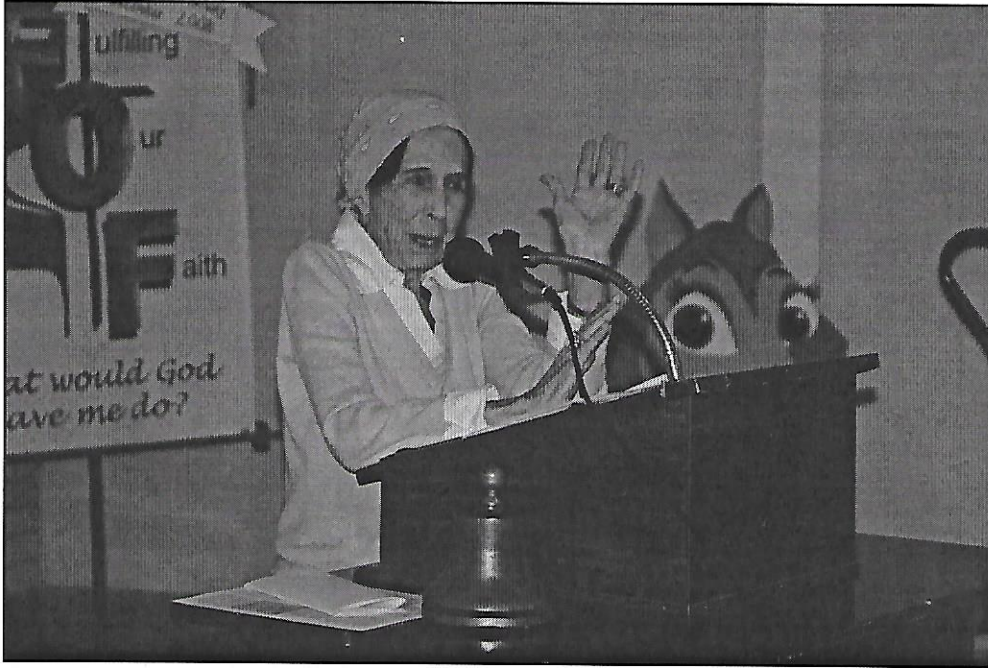

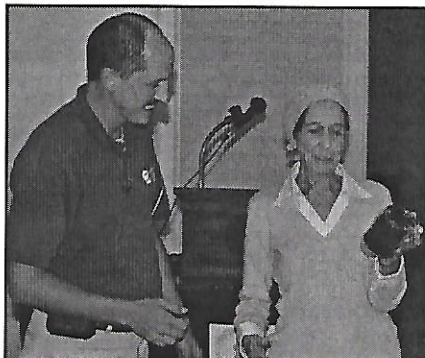
Tibbie Roberts Shares Plans for Honoring D. G. Bell with Special Appreciation Day

The Four-Way Test

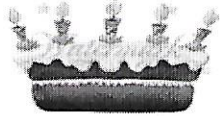
1. Is it the TRUTH?

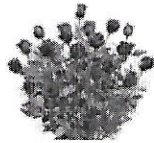
