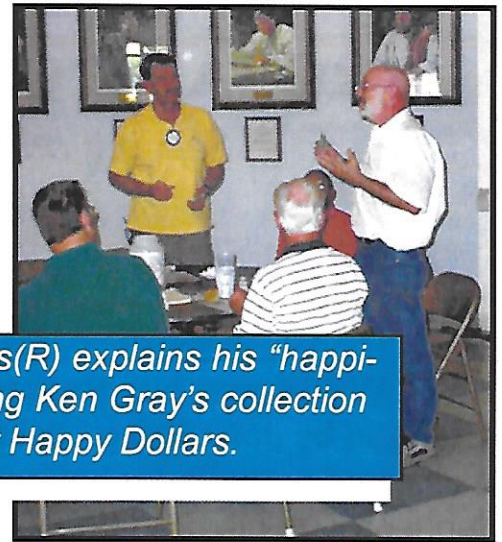

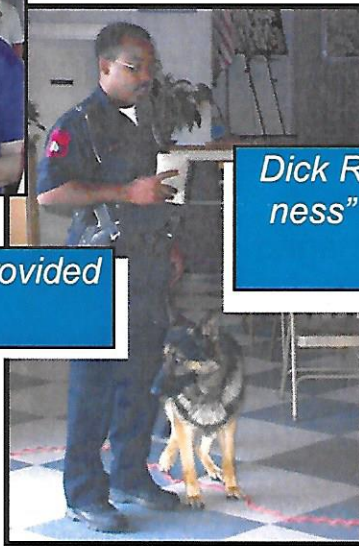

Last week we mentioned that Rotary would soon be 100 years old. Here are some statistics you might find interesting.

- * The average life expectancy in the U.S. was 47years.
- * Only 14 percent of the homes in the U.S. had a bathtub.
- * Only 8 percent of the homes had a telephone.
- * A three-minute call from Denver to New York City cost eleven dollars.
- * The average wage in the U.S. was 22 cents an hour.
- * The average U.S. worker made between \$200 and \$400 per year.
- * Sugar was 4 cents a pound; Eggs, 14 cents per doz; Coffee, 15 cents per pound.
- * The five leading causes of death in the U.S. were:
 1. Pneumonia and influenza
 2. Tuberculosis
 3. Diarrhea
 4. Heart disease
 5. Stroke
- * The American flag had 45 stars. Arizona, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Hawaii, and Alaska hadn't been admitted to the Union yet.
- * The population of Las Vegas, Nevada, was 30.
- * There were only about 230 reported murders in the entire U.S.
