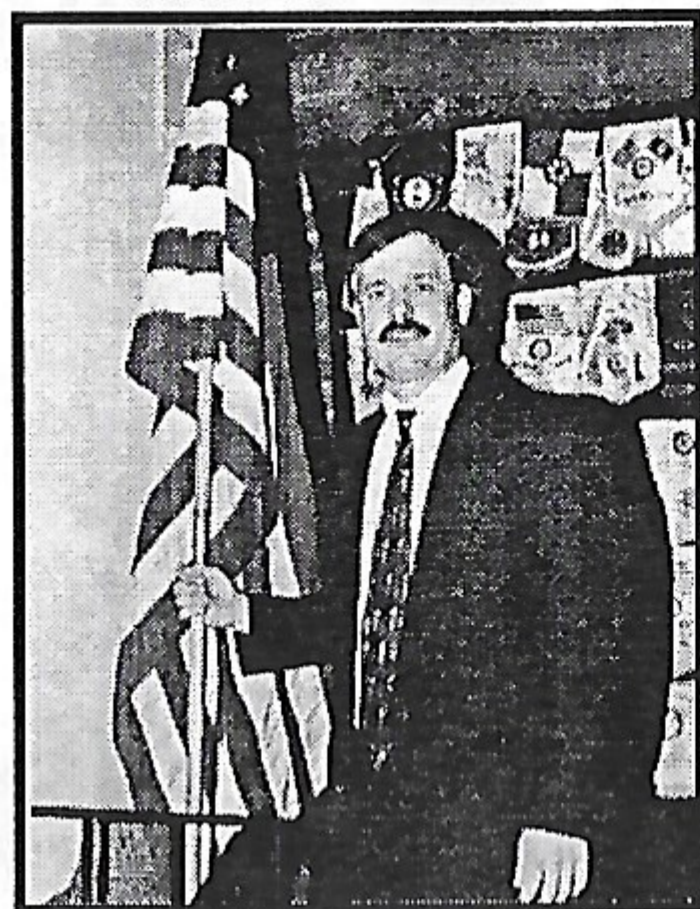


Bill Walker, District Governor

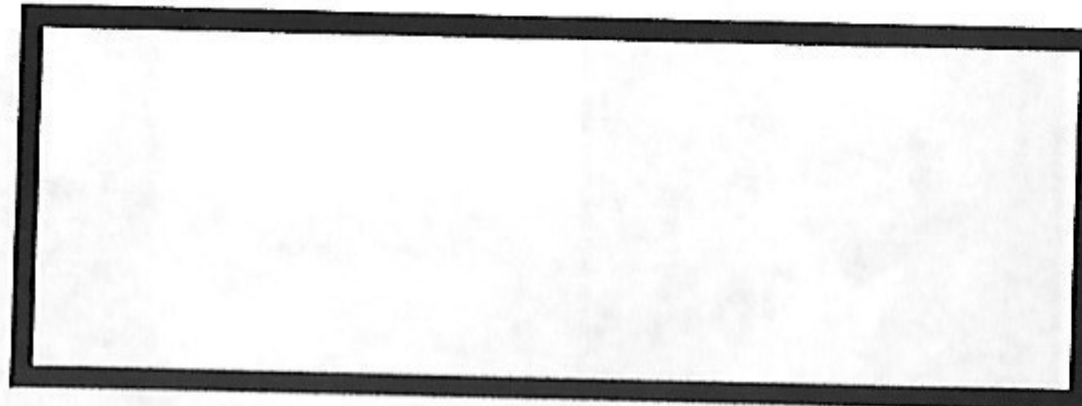
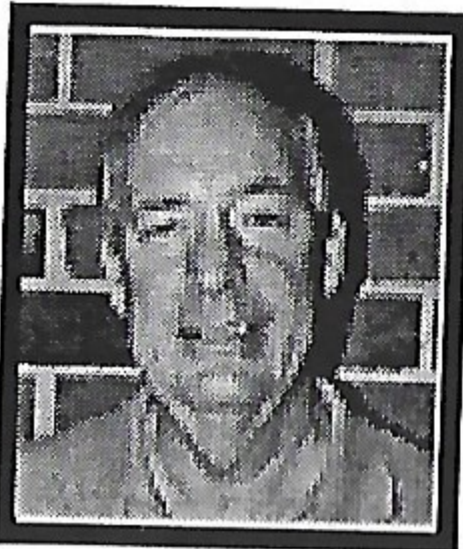


Richard Abel has the program July 3. Traditionally at the first meeting, the new president discusses his vision for the club and the directors outline their plan of work for the coming year

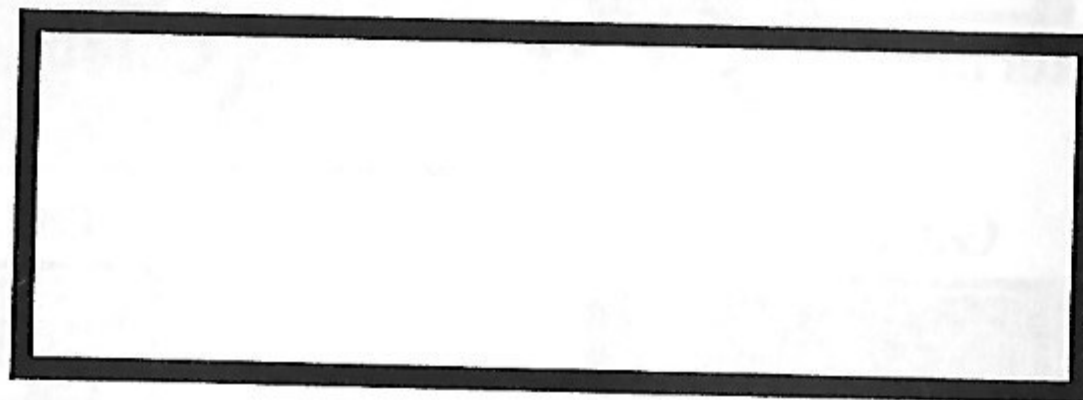
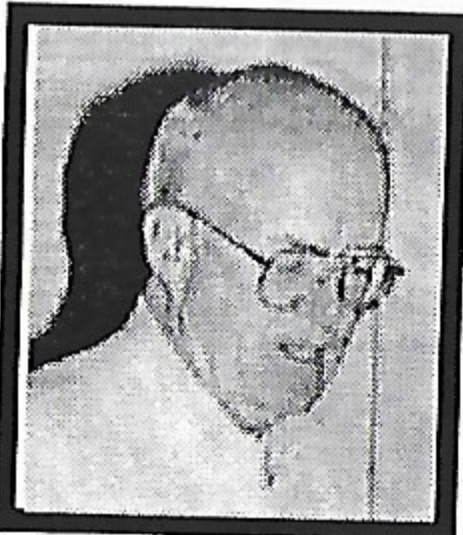

The Club's Most Prestigious Award

Each year the Morehead City Rotary Club confers the title of *Rotarian-of-the-Year* to one of its members for outstanding performance in the club. The purpose of the award is to encourage active participation in Rotary by all members through social, professional, and community service. The recipient of the award receives \$500 toward a Paul Harris Fellow and a plaque engraved with the Rotarian's name and the nature of the award. If the member is already a Paul Harris Fellow, the \$500 can be used to make the Rotarian's spouse, another family member, or a fellow Rotarian a sustaining Paul Harris Fellow. All members in good standing are eligible to receive the award.
