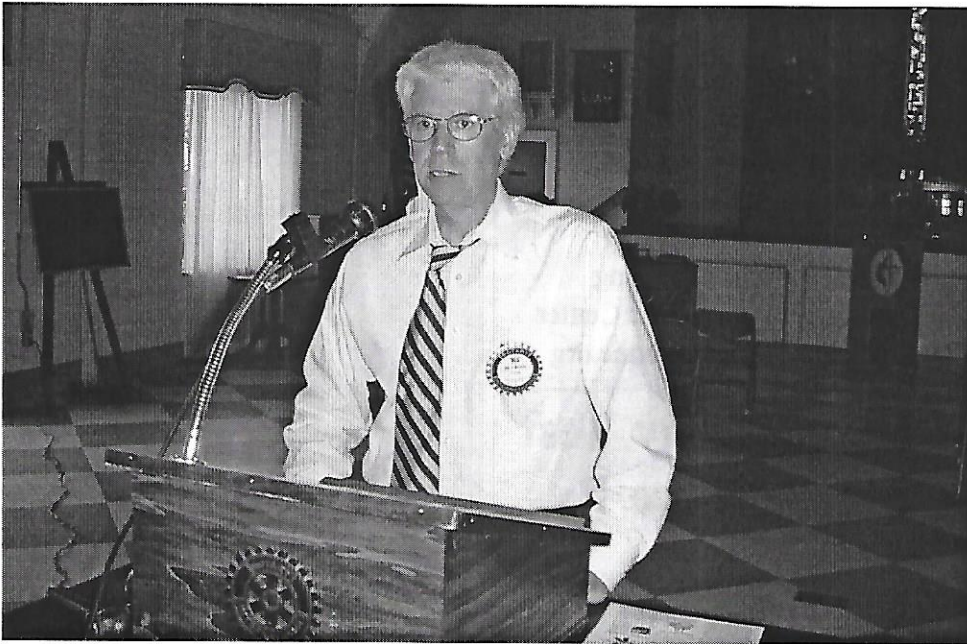

Mary Fournier Discusses Scope of Health Department

Have you ever wondered exactly what the health department does? At last week's meeting, Mary Fournier, with only about 10 minutes to collect her thoughts, gave an excellent extemporaneous talk on exactly this topic. As it turns out the Health Department does quite a lot of things.

The overall mission of public health is to fulfill society's interest in assuring the conditions in which people can be healthy. The health department works to accomplish this mission by: 1) diagnosing and investigating health problems and hazards; 2) linking people to needed personal health services and assuring the provision of health care when it is unavailable; 3) informing and educating the public about health issues; 4) monitoring the health status in the community to identify health problems and needs; and 5) enforcing laws, rules, and regulations that protect the public's health and safety.

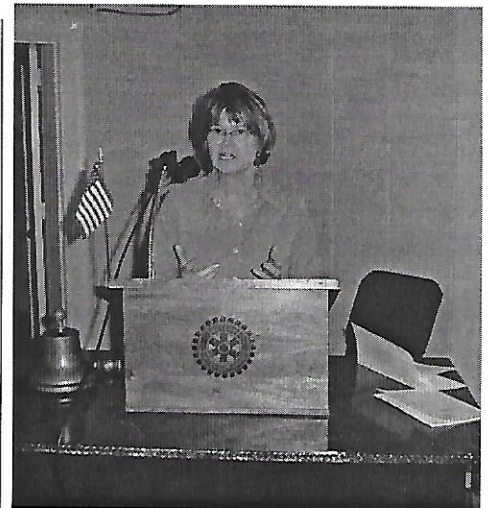
