Last week

Gerald Renfrow introduced David Cartier, Public Relations Coordinator, North Carolina Maritime Museum in Beaufort. Mr. Cartier began his presentation with some of his past experiences and indicated he came to our area in 1997.



Mr. Cartier informed us of several of the museum's exhibits. Of special interest to club members were the QAR artifacts found off our coast. QAR, Queen Anne's Revenge, was a frigate, most famously used as a flagship by the pirate Blackbeard (Edward Teach). He spoke of the 5 to 7 year refurbishment process required to make the recovered artifacts display ready.

Mr. Cartier gave us brochures containing the Museum's Spring Calendar, Summer Science School, and popular Junior Sailing Program.

A 2006 NC CAMA permit and \$300,000 in funds have enabled the recently begun construction of a Harborside Park next to the museum's Harvey Smith Watercraft Center.



There were 215,000 visitors to the museum last year, and future visitors will have an enhanced experience with this Harborside Park addition when watching the custom boat building and restoration projects. Paddle boards and kayaks are constructed in addition to the wooden boats.
