

# Dr. Bill Walker Describes Deplorable Conditions in India and the Daunting Task of Eradicating Polio in a Third World Country

Bill Walker, last week's guest speaker, talked about his recent trip to India with a team of medical personnel whose task was to immunize Indians against the polio virus. Rotarians and friends of Rotary joined health workers in carrying out India's National Immunization Days (NIDs) in January and February, mobilizing public support, vaccinating children, and contributing additional funding to the global polio eradication effort. The new fervor created by this challenge amongst Rotarians has enthused people and helped generate a great deal of awareness and interest about the polio campaign," says India's PolioPlus Committee Chair Deepak Kapur.

Bill said: "After 20 years of hard work, Rotary and its partners are on the brink of eradicating this tenacious disease, but a strong push is needed now to root it out once and for all. It is a window of opportunity of historic proportions." According to Bill, conditions in India are deplorable. Outside large population


