## Employers are key to the Economic Well Being of Any Community

Tom Noe had the program last week. His speaker was Mary Brown, Manager of Carteret County JobLink Career Center which is housed in the Employment Security Commission building located on Commerce Avenue, Morehead City. JobLink Career Centers are user friendly facilities which provide job seekers, training seekers and employers access to a variety of employment and training services all under one roof.

Ms. Brown said that the Employment Secutiry Commission of Carteret County sees between 500-600 people each month. "Although our main focus is job placement, we also offer labor market information and we help employers with the cost of hiring new trainees or employees. If certain criteria are met, we can remiburse an employer up to 90% of an employee's salary for six months. Not a bad deal." Ms. Brown went on to say, "Although the unemployment rate has risen over the last two years. Carteret County's jobless rate is still lower than the state rate by almost a full percentage point. The rate will be even lower when the tourist season kicks in."

As part of her presentation, Ms. Brown passed out an in-depth summary of the employment status in Carteret County. "Our agency," she said, "also participates in the local Job Fair that is held each year at the Civic Center. This and all other services we provide are absolutely free to the public...paid for by taxes."
