






Andy Couch and Bill Frost Involve Student & Parents in Magic Show


Bill Frost Magic Show Enthralls Young Crowd of Prestidigitators






Magic Show Attracts Respectable Crowd

2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
