Rotary's Support of Red Kettle Campaign Helped Raise \$70,000

Dick Roger had the program last week. His guest speaker was Char Penn, a resource specialist and director of social services for The Salvation Army. Char discussed various SA programs that benefit the poor and needy in our community. Char's major responsibility is dispensing funds to clients, who because of illness or natural catastrophe, cannot pay their rent or electric bills, purchase food, or secure prescription drugs needed to treat serious illnesses. The SA also provides temporary housing to families that have to rebuild their lives after their homes have been destroyed by fire or a hurricane.

The SA's three main sources of revenue come from the Red Kettle Campaign, the thrift store in downtown Morehead City and individual and corporate donations. The SA's motto is "Doing the most good." A lofty motto which SA employees carry out in action and deed.
