Fund Raising and Membership Top Priorities For 2011-2012

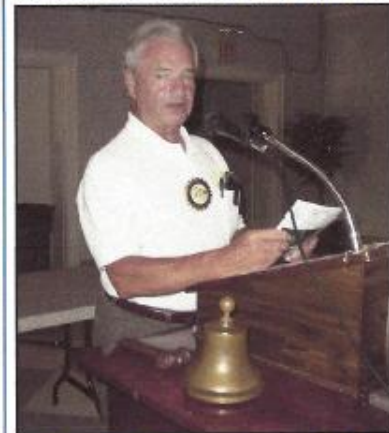

1. Continue operating the drink concession booths at the Seafood Festival but use volunteers instead of students
2. Reduce donations until club is on sound financial footing
3. Hold a golf tournament
4. Resume pancake dinner at church
5. Hold in-house auctions each week
6. Sell lighthouses or other items on e-bay
7. Hold annual yard sale
8. Increase dues to \$500 annually and eliminate fundraisers
9. Hold turkey shoot
