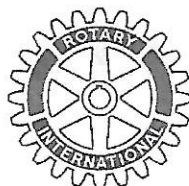

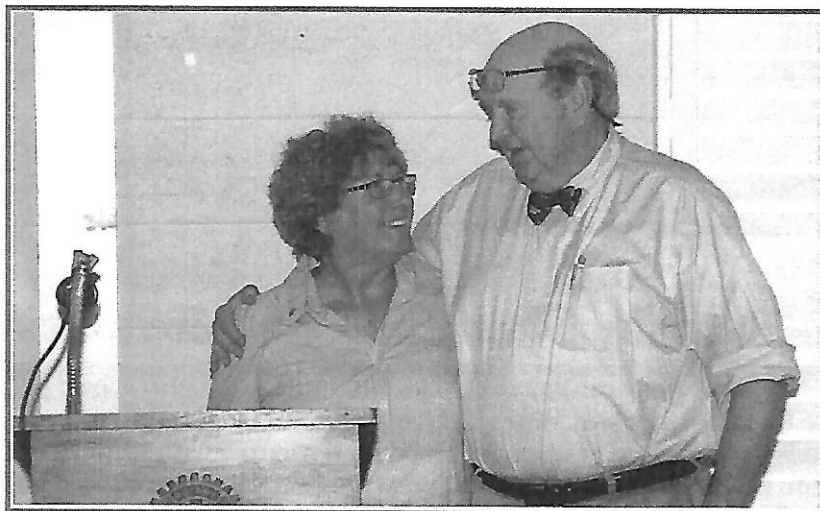

Cape Lookout High School Wins Appeal To Remain Open for Two More Years

Last Week's guest speaker was Barbara Johnson, chairperson of Cape Lookout High School's Advisory Council. Barbara spoke about the school's struggle to maintain its charter in order to remain open.

Cape Lookout High School includes grades 9 through 12 and has fewer than 100 students. Barbara said the school needs to remain open to serve students who do not experience success in a traditional high school setting. The state board said the school must meet four conditions to remain open. These conditions include: no material finding in any audit; no negative fund balance on June 30 of each year; student enrollment cannot fall below 65; and the school must administer tests in all required subjects according to state policy. Kudoes to James Walker and Barbara Johnson for all the hard work they do to keep the school open. The rest is up to the community. Do your part!

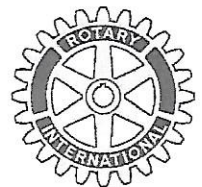
