Dr. Youngblood Loves Carteret County

Community College President Impressed By Carteret County's Southern Hospitality

James Walker had the program last week. His guest speaker was Dr. Kerry Youngblood, the new president of Carteret Community College. Dr. Youngblood has a long and interesting background in education. In 2005, he was selected as the Vice President for Community College Affairs and as the President of Western Colorado Community College in Grand Junction. Shortly after his departure as president, WCCC named one of its buildings in his honor of his contributions to the community college.

Dr. Youngblood said he applied to Carteret Community College because he liked the community. "It is a small college, has a wide range of activities, is actively supported by the community, has a solid philosophy toward education and because of the fishing opportunities on the coast is great." Dr. Youngblood went on to say: "The southern hospitality here is very real and genuine.. There is a sense of community pride and community ownership. All these things greatly appeal to me."

The Four-Way Test

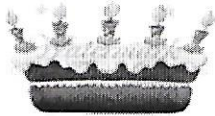
1. Is it the TRUTH?

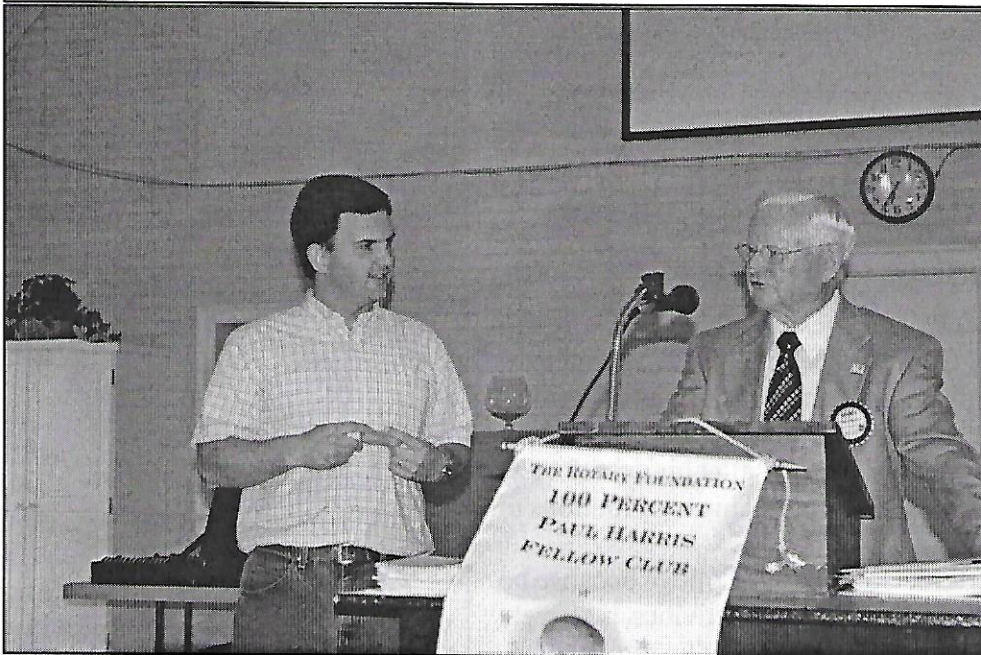
