

Speaker Remembers World's Largest Invasion--Normandy

Last week's speaker Chuck Collins, retired marine, said the invasion of Normandy by allied forces was the largest amphibious invasion to ever take place. The Normandy landings were the first successful opposed landings across the English Channel in over eight centuries. The invasion fleet was drawn from eight different navies, comprising 6,939 vessels. Although the losses were horrendous, allied forces secured a beachhead that eventually led to the defeat of the Nazi war machine.


