A whirlwind trip of the Middle East

Robbie Phillips Takes the Morehead City Rotary Club on a Tour of the Holy Land

Has it always been your dream to visit the holy land? If you are an armchair traveler and can enjoy traveling vicariously, you got your wish..

Last week Jim Phillips had the program . His guest speaker was his daughter-in-law, Robbie Phillips, a recent graduate of Union Presbyterian Seminary in Richmond Va. and a graduate of East Carolina University. Robbie is currently a candidate for Minister of Word and Sacrament with the Presbyterian Church. She is ready to receive a call from the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina. As a culminating activity for her work at the seminary, she journeyed to the Middle East where she spent three weeks traveling around Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Israel and Egypt.

The major portion of her talk focused on Israel and Egypt. For those of you who are biblical scholars, you saw pictures of places that you have always read about in the Bible. You saw the Sea of Galilee, Cassarea Philipi, Nazareth, the Jordon River, St. Peter's Church, Mt. of Olives, Bethlehem, and Qumran, the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. It was a whirlwind trip...taking less than 45 minutes to complete, but it covered every important site mentioned in the Bible. You walked the same land where Jesus was born, lived, healed, ministered, died and was resurrected. And for those of us who have never visited the Holy Land, it gave us tremendous insight into the topography of Israel and the places we have read so much about in the Bible. It was a wonderful journey into realms only dreamed of but never trod before.
