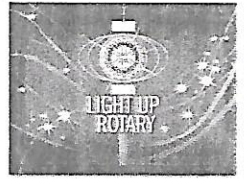

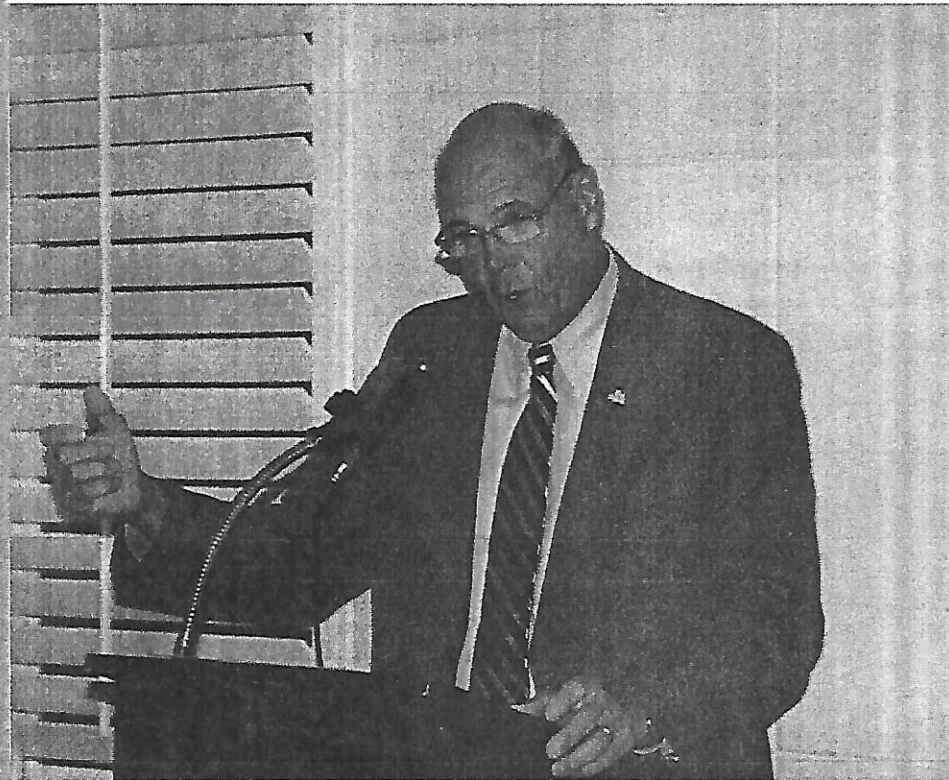

Dan Novey Reports on Schools' Progress

Carteret County School System Ranked One of the Top Systems in the State

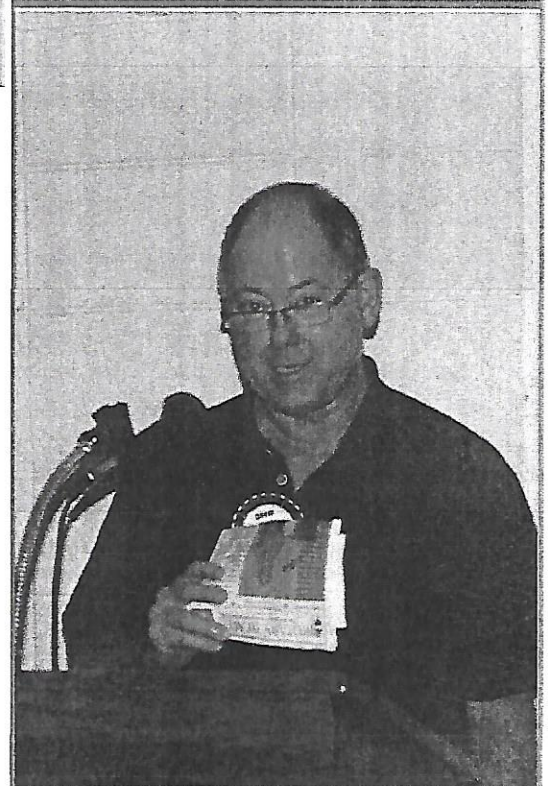
David Bradley had the program last week. His guest speaker was Dr. Dan Novey, Superintendent of Carteret County Schools. Dr. Novey presented a glowing picture of the Carteret County School System. Dr. Novey said, "Last year's third graders ranked 3rd in reading in the state. Quite an accomplishment. Our high school graduation rate is 88 percent, which is fantastic. Our biology students at East Carteret High School rank 4th out of 376 schools in the state. Croatan and West Carteret High Schools are in the top 30. That is not too shabby! Our students scored 86 percent on the SAT compared to the state average of 68 percent. And 95% of high school students passed Algebra II.

"This all has come about because of the hard work of teachers, parents, administrators, board of education, and the community at large. The county commissioners are also to be thanked. We have 100 teachers who are paid with local funds. That's outstanding! In terms of teacher pay, we rank 48-50 out of 115 school systems."

Carteret County has an excellent school system that we can all be proud of.

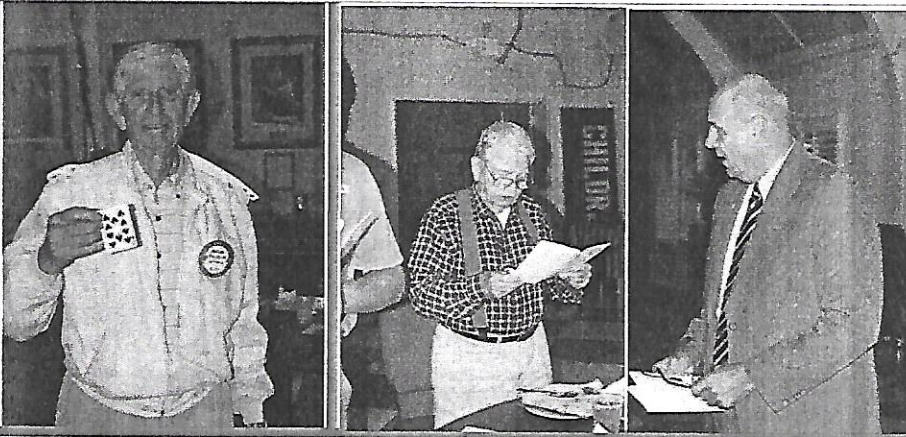

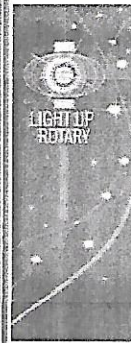

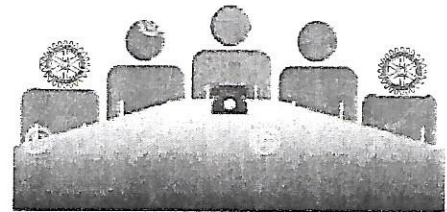
