## City Waterfront to Get a New Look

John Nelson had the program last week. His guest speaker was Maggie Chalk of M.K. Chalk Architecture P.A. of Morehead City. Maggie unveiled her design for the the Jib Plaza which is located where the old Otis Fishhouse used to be. The proposed project will be built in three stages. It includes a tiered pedestal which will support a 17 foot leaping Marlin sculpture; a deck called "Otis Landing" which extends about 70' into the sound; and an open air pavilion roof structure that gives the appearance of a rusticated frame of a boat turned on its hull.

The city, with the support of the Big Rock Tournament and various grants, has funds to cover the first two stages of the project.

Once the project is completed, it will be the centerpiece for Morehead City...just like the Gateway Arch is to St. Louis.

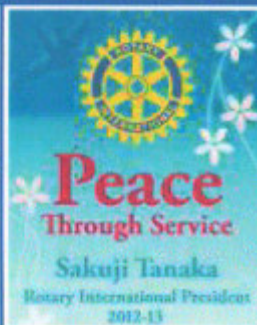

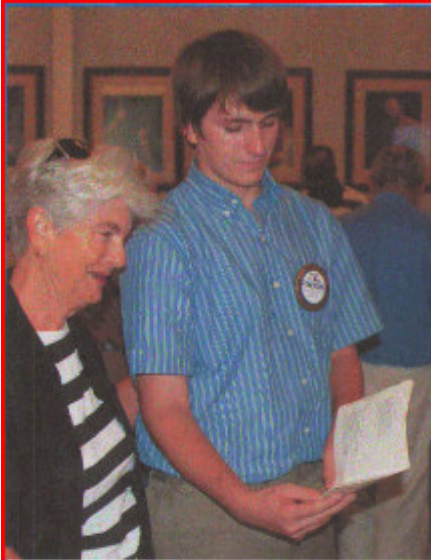

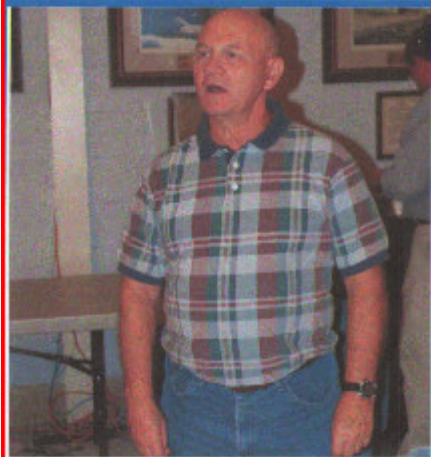
