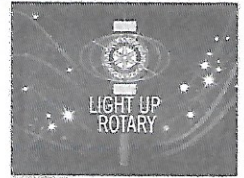

Last night I dreamed I was sitting in a tree on the beach—a scene reminiscent of a Salvador Dali painting. It was surreal. I wonder what it means?

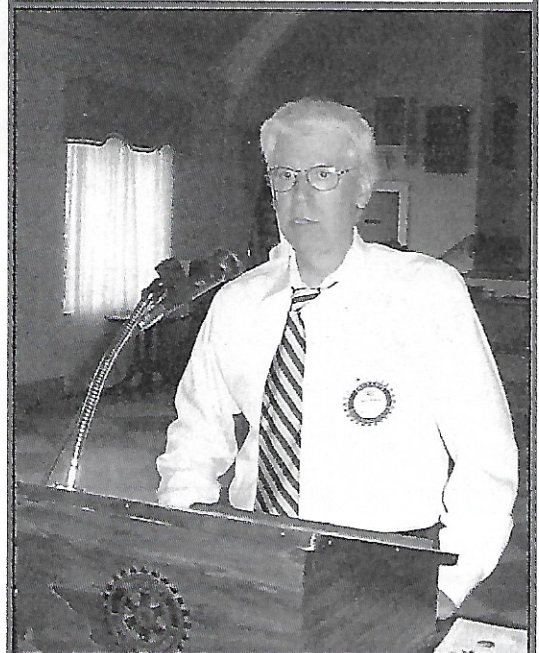
## Dreams: The Gateway to the Subconscious

## Tonight's Program

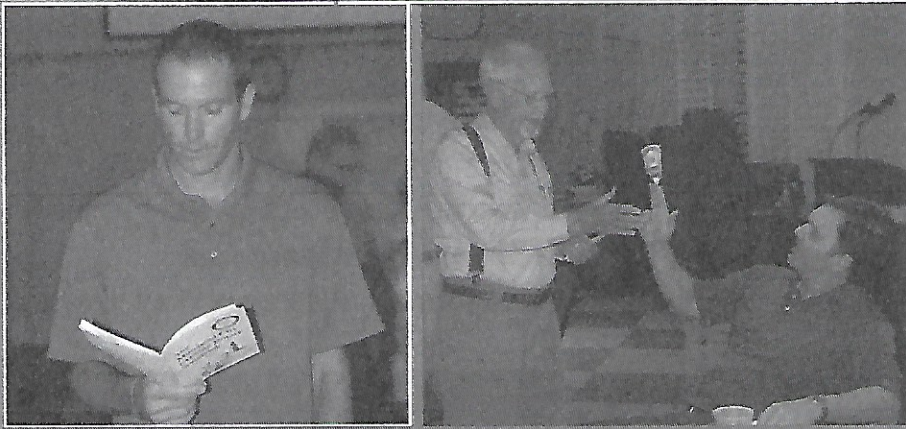
