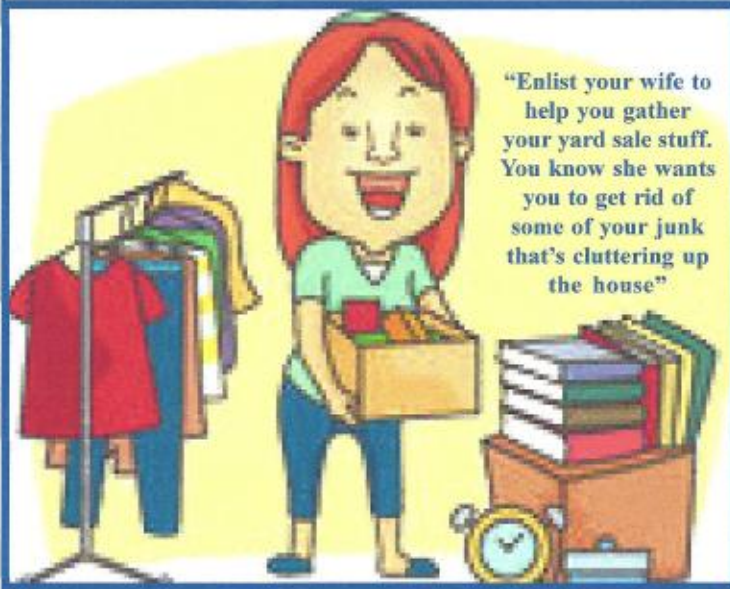

Belk’s Charity Sale

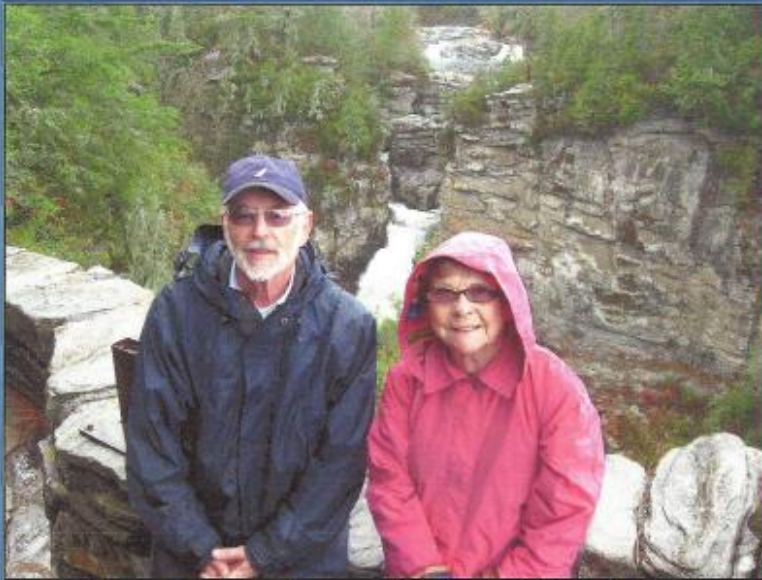
