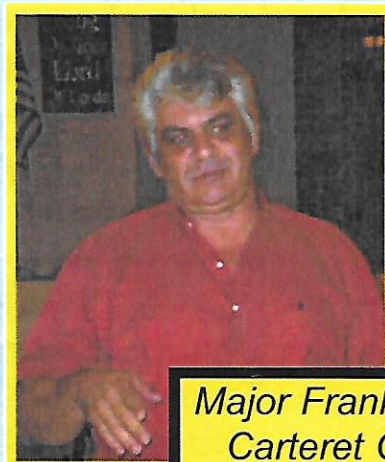
OUR PROGRAM THIS WEEK....
