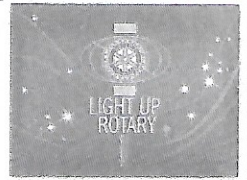

Lindy Robinson Explains New Voting Laws

Voting Procedures Have Changed: A Good Thing or a Bad Thing? Time will Tell!

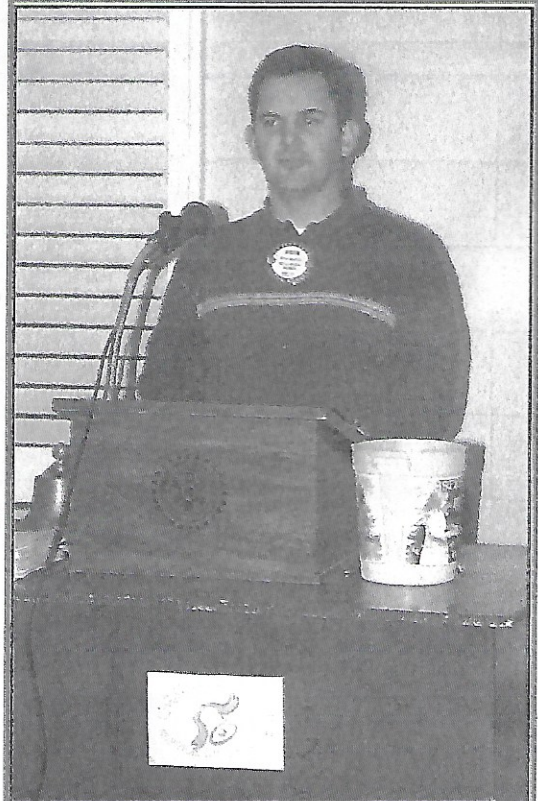
Neil Whitford had the program last week. Neil was unable to attend Rotary, so he had James Walker introduce his guest speaker, Lindy Robinson, Director of Carteret County Board of Elections. Lindy said, "Same-day registration won't be allowed during early voting in North Carolina and Election Day ballots cast in the wrong precinct won't be counted this fall. Another changes that will go into effect in 2016 is the requirement for voters to have a valid ID. Driver's license, military ID or a government issued passport will be acceptable. Student College ID is not acceptable. An expired driver's license will also disqualify a person from voting.

A third change that has already been implemented is straight party voting. The design of the ballot has not changed, but voters must now vote for individuals and not parties.

Backers of the measure say it will increase the confidence voters have in the election system, while opponents say it will place unnecessary hurdles in front of qualified voters, particularly the very young, very old and minorities. Time will tell who is right!

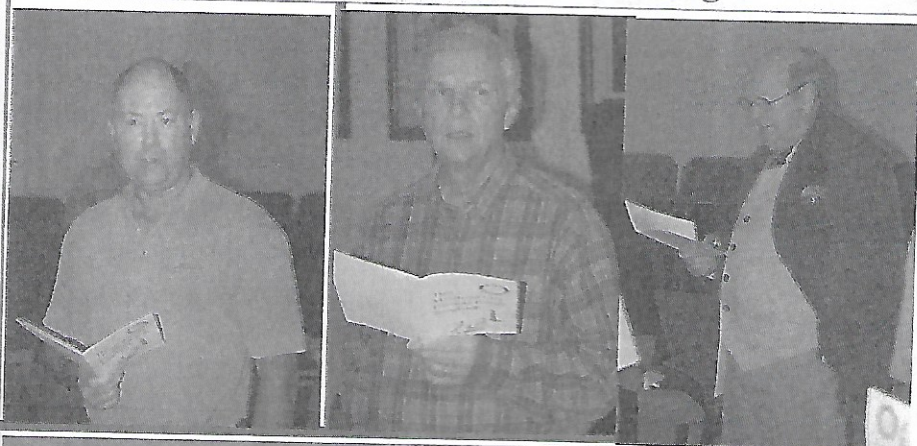

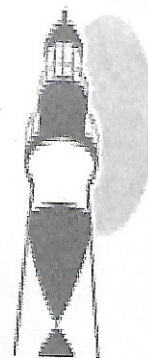

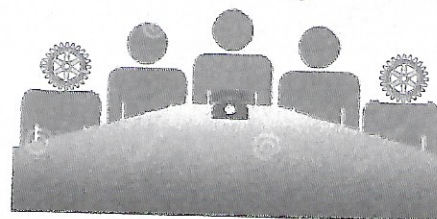
