To illustrate his point, he said that he brought a team from Costa Rica to help flood victims in Louisiana after the devastating hurricane, Katrina. "Help should be a reciprocal process; not only should we receive help, but we should provide it as well."

"Our ministry has grown tremendously over the past 25 years. We receive as many as 35 teams each year. Last year they helped us build classrooms for our local school. We have been blessed."

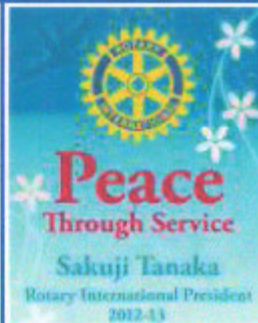
